COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

MATHEMATICS

(In all math classes, except PREP, summer workbook pages will be worked on.)

Grade 2 -available on request

Grade 3 – reinforcement of addition and subtraction facts, time, money, measurement, and word problems.

Grades 4,5 – reinforcement of addition, Subtraction, multiplication facts, long division, fractions, metric system, and word problems.

Grades 6, 7 –number theory, all operations in whole numbers, pre-algebra, and word problems.

READING/ILA/PHONICS

(We conclude each class with a brief reading of their required novel. They will be assigned pages to read each evening, so novel will be completed at the end of sessions.)

Grades 2,3 –reinforcement of phonics rules, comprehension skills, analogies, vocabulary, and novel reading.

Grades 4,5 – reinforcement of reading skills, ILA maintenances, vocabulary, analogies, comprehension, and novel reading.

Grades 6,7 – vocabulary enrichment, ILA maintenances, analogies, and novel reading.

PREP

In both PREP classes, the teachers prepare students for the high school entrance tests administered in the fall. Practice tests are worked on daily and test taking tips are taught. Algebra is stressed in math class, while grammar usage, vocabulary, and analogies are stressed in the ILA class. Many of our SMM students who have attained scholarships were students of our PREP classes.

The PREP class is also offered in the fall. Classes are on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday afternoons. Those classes are set to begin on 9/13/11. If you are considering fall classes, please register now, with a \$50 deposit. All textbooks are ordered in May.

Individual private tutoring, for any grade level, is available at the end of scheduled classes. The fee for private tutoring is \$40 per session.
