## Spring Cleaning for Our Souls

Calling God's Powerful Spirit (*GPS*) enables us to comfort the afflicted and afflict the comfortable.

Our Lord is loving, forgiving, slow to anger, and abounding in kindness. Be merciful and compassionate to those hungry for salvation, and you will enjoy pardon and peace. Grow as a faithful and forgiving disciple of our crucified and risen Lord by committing ourselves to practice the following:

"If we die with the Lord, we will rise with the Lord."

Missionary Disciples of Jesus are witness to the unconditional Love and Mercy of Jesus, who died for our sins and rose to bless us with the gift of salvation. To grow in a dynamic relationship with Jesus, we must believe He is the Way and the Truth to eternal life. Our redeemer enables us to be reverent, respectful, and responsible for our salvation and those we love.

Lent reminds us to purify our minds, hearts, and souls. Many people want Jesus to simply 'dust' them a little or 'brush over' them with a damp rag—very few desire Jesus to get out the vacuum cleaner and get down to some serious spring cleaning. Fewer still want Jesus to wipe off the cords, knock over those things in their lives that are not His will, and drive them out.

In cleansing the Temple, Jesus expresses his "holy anger" to confront the demonic roots of our sins. We all fall short of the glory of God and need to correct our conscience to obey God's Commandments.

1. Believe that Jesus loves you and paid the price for your sins, so receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation to experience his pardon and peace.
2. Ask the Holy Spirit to take you to the cross and convict you of sin (*Jn 16:8*).
3. Ask the Lord to forgive your unknown faults and to heal your subconscious mind (*Ps 19:13*).
4. By God's grace, decide to forgive everyone and apologize to those you have delayed in forgiving.
5. Pray to heal your mind, body, and spirit.
6. Purify your body by fasting from sin and feast on the completion of good deeds.
7. Receive the Body and Blood of Christ to be His presence, power, and peace to restore in you a joyful spirit for those we love and serve and for all who you love and serve.

**Praise:** *Praise You, Risen Lord Jesus! You defeated Satan by your cross and resurrection. Praise You, victorious Lamb of God! May the Body and Blood of Christ keep us safe for eternal life.*

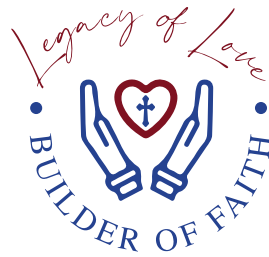

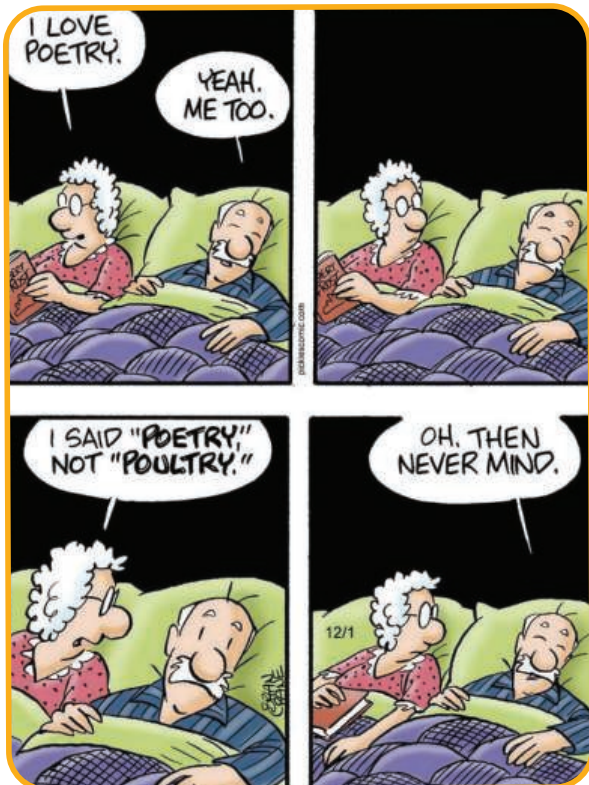
