As Christmas dawns, I will leave it to Christina Rossetti to summarize the excitement of the hour:

*Christmas hath darkness
Brighter than the blazing noon,
Christmas hath a chillness
Warmer than the heat of June,
Christmas hath a beauty
Lovelier than the world can show:
For Christmas bringeth Jesus,
Brought for us so low.*

*Earth, strike up your music,
Birds that sing and bells that ring;

Bridal robe of spotless snow:
For Christmas bringeth Jesus,

I am grateful to all of you for your faithfulness to Christ and your support of our parish community this Christmas and throughout the year!

Keeping Christ in Christmas

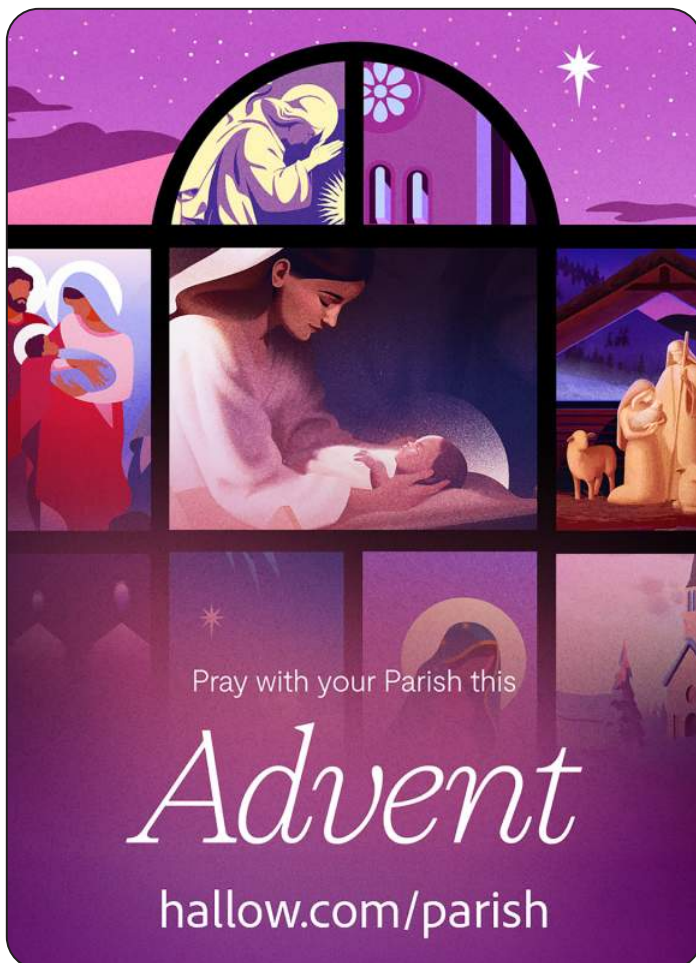
