A Conversation with Msgr. Chieffo



Each year, to develop a closer spiritual relationship between students, parish leaders, and faculty, **Mrs. Maureen Clark** invited her fourth-grade students to interview them. Below is an article by **Harper Dobosz**, from her interview with **Msgr. Chieffo**. Over the coming weeks, we will share some of the additional interviews in future issues.

I would have never guessed that Monsignor was ordained on May 17, 1975. That was 47 years ago! I found it interesting when I asked him if he liked his job. He responded, "Since my vocation to the priesthood is a response to God, I love showing the mercy and kindness of Jesus to others. As I tell everyone, joy is loving Jesus, others, and yourself. Jesus invites all of us to love and serve one another. Our parents answered the call by being good to each other through the sacrament of marriage, and children answer by being obedient and respectful to their parents."

Monsignor told me that he dislikes when people refuse to love and forgive each other. He becomes sad like Jesus. What he believes is that prayer helps us all with our difficulties. A couple of things Monsignor would change about his job are being able to spend more time praying and helping others, coming closer to Jesus. Monsignor said the most interesting thing about his job are the people and the blessing of seeing the face of God in them. He thinks it is wonderful when our parents, family, teachers, and coaches love and care for us so much, especially when they care and correct us to be and do our best.

Surprisingly, he doesn't have any family that are priests, but he prays each day for someone from the parish family to be called by God to become a priest. He asks everyone to pray for more priests.

I asked Monsignor which grade behaved the best in church. He told me that he believes and prays that everyone behaves because Jesus blesses us with His very body, blood, soul, and divinity.

I loved interviewing Monsignor Chieffo, and I hope he liked being interviewed as well.

It's Catholic Schools Week! The 4th grade is doing a newspaper on all of the faculty and staff. I interviewed Mrs. Brown on January 7, 2022. Due to Covid-19, we had to do the interview over email.

Mrs. Brown is the Director of Religious Education. She sets up all PREP activities, and sacraments for St. Mary Magdalen School. She also teaches piano to all ages.

Mrs. Brown has been a teacher for 34 years! Fifteen of those years were at a performing arts school in Massachusetts. She shared with me that she has taught at SMM, St. Thomas the Apostle School, Archmere Academy, Haverford School, and at Franklin School.

I learned that Mrs. Brown has wanted to be a teacher since she was a child. She would always play "school" in her basement with a chalkboard and pretend students. I would have never guessed that Mrs. Brown has taught kids from 18 months all the way to adults! She told me she has taught grades 2,3,6, and 7th. She also choreographed shows for high schoolers!

I liked that Mrs. Brown said that teaching anything can be fun with the right approach, so that's why she doesn't have a favorite subject. My favorite response is when Mrs. Brown stated, " If I weren't a teacher, I would like to be a princess. I would really like to be a princess." I had so much fun interviewing Mrs. Brown.

I hope I will get to talk to her in person one day!

TODAY'S REFLECTION

**Jeremiah 1:4-5, 17-19, Psalm 71:1-6, 15-17,
1 Corinthians 12:31-13-13, & Luke 4:21-30**

In today's Gospel narrative, our Lord is once again speaking in the synagogue. He tells His listeners, "Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." The people were amazed at Jesus' preaching, and they spoke highly of Him. Some asked, "Isn't this the son of Joseph?" Were they wondering how Jesus had become such a scholar and preacher? After all, His father, Joseph, was only a carpenter.

How often do we discount someone's gifts or talents because they do not have the formal education or training? We don't want others to judge us, yet most of us judge each other, even without knowing them, all the time. We may not like the way a person speaks, dresses, acts. However, we feel the pain of being judged or ignored for superficial reasons, yet we generate the same hurt by being judgmental ourselves.

Some in the synagogue dismissed Jesus simply because He was a "lowly" carpenter. Other individuals were "amazed" by His presence, teaching, and presence. As you come to know the person of Jesus, are you amazed by Him? Conversely, have you lost the thrill, the joy, and the wonder you experienced when Jesus first became real to you and no longer was just a character in the Holy Bible?

Today, I invite you to sit in a quiet place and contemplate Jesus' presence. Be attentive to how you feel and what you experience in the silence. May your mind and heart be open and recognize His presence. Our Lord is with you. He will never fail you—Never.

Question of the Day: Will you accept everyone you meet regardless of their background?

Prayer: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom of Heaven. Blessed are the meek, for they shall possess the land." (Mt 5:3-4)

First Reconciliation for SMM School children is Tuesday, February 1, at 6:30 p.m. in church.

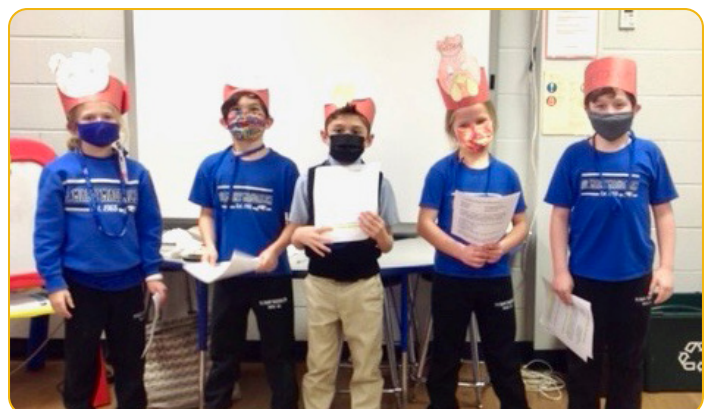
First Reconciliation for PREP children is Tuesday, February 8, at 6:30 p.m. in church.

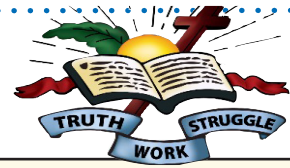

ARE YOU CALLED TO BE A DEACON? THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 17

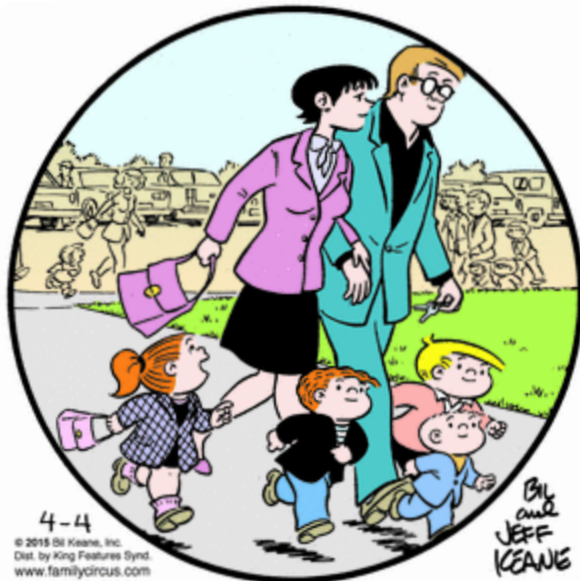
