The Cross That Heals



What a blessing and joy to serve as your pastor.

As we grow older, we need to be honest about what we can and cannot do for the good of those we care for and love. True love means to love and serve like Jesus. I praise God and thank everyone, especially our deacons, parish staff, ministry leaders, and all who collaborate with me in "building a family of faith in Jesus Christ through Catholic worship, formation, and charity."

The Good News in today's gospel is that God initiated his unconditional love and mercy while we were still sinners. If we are willing to be merciful to others, our weakness can become God's strength.

Cyril of Alexandria explains the spiritual meaning of the bronze serpent, which points to the saving work of Jesus Christ:

"This story is a type of the whole mystery of the incarnation. For the serpent signifies bitter and deadly sin, which was devouring the whole race on the earth... biting the Soul of man and infusing it with the venom of wickedness. There is no way that we could have escaped being conquered by it except by the relief

that comes only from heaven. The Word of God then was made in the likeness of sinful flesh, 'that he might condemn sin in the flesh.' In this way, he becomes the Giver of unending salvation to those who comprehend the divine doctrines and gaze on him with steadfast faith. But the serpent, being fixed upon a lofty base, signifies that Christ was clearly manifested by his passion on the Cross so that none could fail to see him."

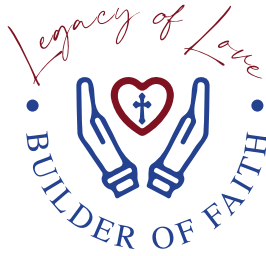
