**VIRTUE=STRENGTH™
THE VIRTUE OF FORTITUDE**

During March, our students are practicing the **virtue of fortitude**, which is the strength to do the right thing in the face of fear or difficulties. Fortitude is the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in pursuing the good. It strengthens the resolve to resist temptations and to overcome obstacles in the moral life. Fortitude enables one to conquer fear, even fear of death, and to face trials and persecutions—even to renounce and sacrifice one's life in defense of a just cause. This virtue enables us to persevere in our goals and helps us to control our emotions and fears so we can do the good and avoid the evil.

To help our children to practice this virtue, read stories with them about martyred or persecuted saints. Find a Bible verse about fortitude or courage and memorize it. Pray for the gift of fortitude. It is a grace, a gift received from God.

Family Resolution: Walk, jog, or run as a family for a specific distance, offering it up for an intention

Practice praying in public, for example: Cross yourself and pray when you're out to eat.

NEW! BUILDING HOLY FAMILIES

Parents trying to build holy families today are walking through a minefield. One false step and the family blows up. Surveys show that the best way to pass on faith is for both parents to practice the faith.

If we want our next generation to grow in holiness, we need the fidelity, mercy, kindness, and compassion of both our Blessed Mother and St. Joseph. We need to pray to Holy Mary and St. Joseph.

Our Mother blesses us with eternal love, while Saint Joseph shows us how to provide, protect, and promote faith through devotion. When Joseph discovered Mary was expecting a child, he planned to divorce her quietly and not expose her to shame.

Being a man of devout faith, Joseph obeyed whatever God asked of him without question. When the angel came to Joseph in a dream and told him the truth, Joseph immediately and without question or concern took Mary as his wife. When the angel appeared again to tell him that his family was in danger, he immediately left everything he owned, his family and friends, and fled to a strange country with his young wife and newborn. He waited in Egypt without question until the angel told him it was safe to return.

St. Joseph's trust in God's plan and his faithfulness and loyalty to Mary teach us how to be confident and courageous in building a culture of life. When

our men's cenacle come together to share the revelations of Elizabeth Kindelmann's Flame of Love from Jesus and Our Blessed Mother, we learn how men and women differ in passing on their faith.

While women depend on creating personal interconnections and sharing feelings, men tend to fix and provide solutions to protect their families but often hesitate to promote their relationship with Jesus.

Most men come to our men's groups through the invitation of their wives. God's powerful Flame of Love helps men forge feminine virtues and women develop masculine virtues. By living a life of virtue,

Dr. John J. and Dr. Margaret T. Clark were devoted Saint Mary Magdalen Parish members. The Clarks directed that a gift be made through their estate to endow scholarships for students who were members of Saint Mary Magdalen parish toward their post-secondary education.

Annually, the Saint Mary Magdalen Scholarship Committee selects one eligible student to receive a scholarship toward two (2) years of undergraduate tuition for their chosen college, university, or trade school. The scholarship is \$5,000 per year for up to two years.

Eligibility for this scholarship requires that the student attended Saint Mary Magdalen School or Saint Mary Magdalen PREP (Parish Religious Education Program).






