TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

One might say that the United States has been founded many times.

There was, of course, the first founding, when the Declaration of Independence was signed 250 years ago this summer. That founding was an assertion of rights—deemed to be based on “self-evident” truths—which the members of the Continental Congress determined had been violated by the “long train of abuses and usurpations” by King George III and his government. We rightly honor the genius and bravery of the American founders, even as history has rightly pointed out their hypocrisies (many owned slaves), their blind spots (many were Freemasons) and even their anti-Catholicism (one of the complaints in the Declaration itself was against the Quebec Act, which allowed Catholicism to be a quasi-established religion after Great Britain had assumed rule of Canada from the French).

But despite the inconsistencies, the first founding prevailed for a time, until the second founding, the Constitutional Convention, which met back in Philadelphia in 1787 and did almost the same thing the Declaration of Independence had done—propose an end to one form of government and the beginning of another.

The nation had to be re-founded again in the 1850s, when the grave injustice buried in the Constitution—that a human being need only be counted as three-fifths of one for taxation and census purposes—exploded into the slavery question and the subsequent Civil War. Abraham Lincoln dared to preserve the Union, knowing what that would cost, including, in the end, his own life.

One might say that the United States was re-founded again in the first half of the twentieth century, when a continental nation, happily on the outskirts of global issues, became the great hegemonic force in the world.

On this 250th anniversary of that first founding, are we in need of one again? None of these (re-)foundings I mentioned (and I could mention others) produced a perfect polity. But they were good efforts to respond to the needs of the world as it existed in that time—this is the role of prudence, to determine what the natural and Divine laws demand at a given time and in a given situation.

Today, it seems to me that the primary crisis among us is neither legal nor geopolitical, but spiritual and moral. Yes, there might be political reforms to our institutions, which would make good sense, but as the motto of my college alma mater says (quoting Horace), “leges sine moribus vanae”—laws without morals are useless. Indeed, James Madison in the Federalist Papers insisted that the government that was designed in Philadelphia in 1787 was a government of free, moral, and honest people who desired to live in a Res Publica—a republic of laws ordered toward the common good of the community. It seems to me that we have lost that fundamental sense of who we are, and our institutions have become degraded as a result.

In our public life, only technological mastery of the world (even at the cost of people and values we hold dear!) seems to have any currency, and only power and money offer real possibilities for effecting change. A small few are unimaginably rich and powerful, while so many live in the “quiet desperation” of Thoreau. At times, walking through the streets of Philadelphia, I can see—more than any political or economic failures—the moral and spiritual failure of hyper-individualism, consumerism, and a loss of shared culture rooted in worship of the one true God. Indeed, a faithful Catholic Christian should never expect to live an easy life without suffering, but neither should he or she expect to end up lying on a sidewalk on Walnut Street as several people do each day. (Special shout-out to Christ in the City Missionaries who minister to such people with the charity of Christ.)

The destructive wake of millions of abortions, broken families, neighborhoods torn apart by strife, and technological advances, which have left many strong communities reeling, have left us at a moral crossroads. Will we seek to embrace God’s plan for our country, or will we choose the way of conflict, vulgarity, and assertion of power over and against others?

Alexis de Tocqueville presciently wrote almost 200 years ago in *Democracy in America* the following words: “I believe that our descendants will tend more and more to be divided into only two parts, those leaving Christianity entirely and those entering into the bosom of the Roman Church.” This, to my mind, is the great question of our time and place in the history of our country. The process is playing out in real time. The answer will determine what kind of re-founding we will have in this era of history.

May the Lord grant you peace!
