THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Cabrini: Strength in Action

***"I am troubled now. Yet what should I say?
Father, save me from this hour?"***

We hear our Lord's words in this week's Gospel, and for those who have seen the new movie **Cabrini**, the answer is a resounding "No!" Mother Cabrini's life, a testament of courage, encapsulates our month's virtue—Fortitude.

"Fortitude is the moral virtue that ensures firmness in difficulties and constancy in the pursuit of the good." (CCC 1808) As a gift of the Holy Spirit, fortitude promises us resolve under challenging times and, at times, difficult people. By emulating Mother Cabrini's courage and fortitude, our newly Confirmed 7th-graders can grow and become stronger in their faith and lives.

In Mother Cabrini and her community of Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we witness the feminine genius and the lives of women who, like many of us, faced daunting challenges. They answered the call to strength through action by becoming missionary disciples of immigrants and orphans. Mother Cabrini boldly proclaimed, "We are bold, or we die." Cabrini and those she was trying to serve had no choice but to be bold, for without fortitude, they would die.

We can choose to die—die to fear and the paralyzing effect of isolation. During Lent, we are not just challenged to avoid complacency and sin. We are called to actively transform ourselves, pursue virtue, and find hope in this transformative journey.

Or, we can choose to be bold in our lives every day.

Community living is bold. We have the power to be bold enough to be missionary disciples in our community, to forgive and seek forgiveness in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and to be daring enough to follow Cabrini's example of finding joy through the living of the Gospel.

Mother Cabrini's energy, motivation, and inspiration came from her burning love for the Sacred Heart of Jesus and her profound gratitude. Utterly confident that she was loved by God, her gratitude propelled her to reach out to each person she met and draw them into a relationship with Christ.



Pray: Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, thank you for the gift of life and your servant, Saint Frances Cabrini. Fill us with the fire of your love and root in us the same spirit that animated Mother Cabrini. Renew our hearts so we may live as she did, faithful and open to your will. Amen.

Dr. John J. and Dr. Margaret T. Clark were devoted Saint Mary Magdalen Parish members. The Clarks directed that a gift be made through their estate to endow scholarships for students who were members of Saint Mary Magdalen parish toward their post-secondary education.

Annually, the Saint Mary Magdalen Scholarship Committee selects one eligible student to receive a scholarship toward two (2) years of undergraduate tuition for their chosen college, university, or trade school. The scholarship is \$5,000 per year for up to two years.

Eligibility for this scholarship requires that the student attended Saint Mary Magdalen School or Saint Mary Magdalen PREP (Parish Religious Education Program).




