## The Eucharist Unites Us to Jesus and One Another



THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

APRIL 28, 2024

Today, some of our second graders will receive their First Holy Communion along with their families, friends, and our faith family, beginning with our PREP students at the 11:30 AM Mass, followed by our school students next Sunday, May 5, at 11:30 AM. Take time to recall your own First Communion and praise God for the blessings you received by practicing our Catholic Faith. As the children prepared their hearts for Jesus by receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, let us examine our conscience to see how we can be better disciples of Jesus. God calls us to be role models of divine love and mercy for his children.

Why does Jesus refer to himself as the true vine? The prophets spoke of the house of Israel as 'the vineyard of the Lord.' While God chose Israel to be his people, they still fell into sin, 'yielding wild grapes.' When Jesus calls himself the true vine, he emphasizes that genuine spiritual fruitfulness and moral goodness can only come from being deeply rooted in God and his life-giving word. Simply being part of a religious community is not enough. As Missionary Disciples of Jesus, we must be firmly rooted in the 'Tree of Life.'

Only Jesus claims he is the true source of divine and human life. The Sacrament of Baptism grafts us to the true vine, Jesus, who blesses us with the fruits of righteousness, peace, and joy. The vinedresser must carefully prune the vine before it can bear good fruit. Vines have two branches—those that bear fruit and those that do not. Jesus says there can be no fruit in our lives apart from him. The fruit he speaks of here is the Fruits of the Holy Spirit. The Lord promises that we will bear much fruit if we abide in him and allow him to purify us. Do you trust in the Lord's healing and transforming power to give you the abundant life and fruit of his heavenly kingdom?

**PRAY:** "Jesus, may I be one with you in all that I say and do. Draw me close that I may glorify you and bear fruit for your kingdom. In flame my heart with your love and remove from me anything that would hinder me from loving and serving you with all my mind, body, and soul."

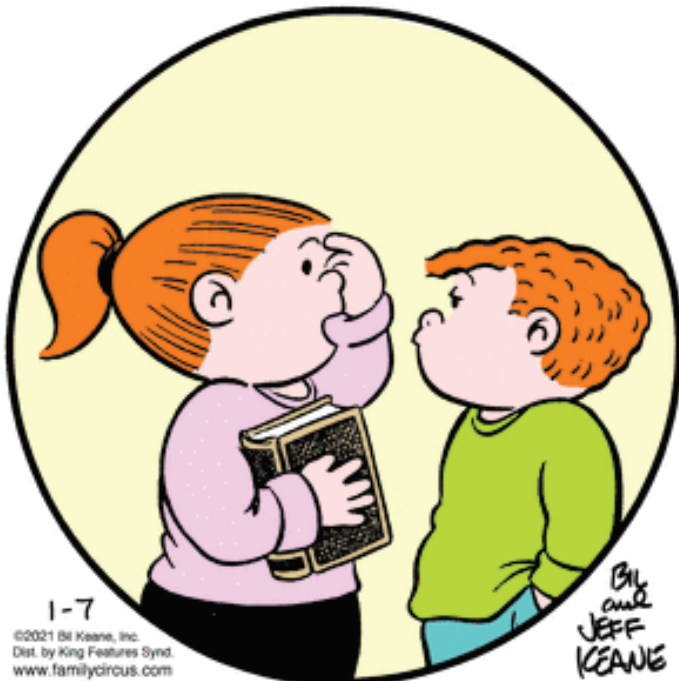
