SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

OUR FATHER, PART III

Let's get our cards out on the table up front: fatherhood is a fraught and difficult topic in our world. And how could it not be? Here's a statistic: there are about 15.7 million children being raised in the United States in a household without a father. The terrible scourge of abortion that the Church in the United States has correctly decried for so long is tied to this reality—nothing would bring the abortion rate down so quickly like women who trusted that the men in their lives would be provident fathers. In the Church, people like me are called "father"—and yet, hasn't the last fifty years given us every reason to see the failure of spiritual fathers too? Perhaps you have had a negative experience with human or spiritual fatherhood yourself. That experience wounds us profoundly.

Yet, for all that, we lose something essential by jettisoning the concept of fatherhood. Are not terrible problems caused by father wounds proof precisely of the importance of fatherhood?

We can even be tempted to abandon the language of fatherhood with regard to God. Better to speak of "creator" or "parent" or even "mother" so as not to offend anyone or "trigger" anyone. But the Lord Jesus was unambiguous on this point. True, the first person of the Trinity is not an old man in the sky with a beard. But he is God the Father. That is how Jesus, his Divine Son, spoke of him. That is how he taught his disciples to pray: "Our Father who art in heaven." In other words, through union with Jesus, we are integrated into his own intimate dialogue of love with the Father in the Holy Spirit.

By praying in this way, we share in the very life of God.

When we open our hearts to God our Father, something amazing happens. We take Jesus' posture of prayer and, like a child, learn to receive everything from God and to offer it back to him in gratitude. Recall Jesus' love for children, which seems so obvious to us but not to his contemporaries! Children were not treated with the kind of romanticism we hold them with today. They were seen as difficult and a burden. Yet Jesus rebukes the disciples who try to keep the children away from him. Along the way, he tells them "unless you turn and become like children, you will not enter the Kingdom of God" (Mt 18:3).

This surely came from his Divine childhood. In the Gospel of John, in his Last Supper discourse, he speaks out of this experience: "Do you not believe that I am in the Father and that the Father is in me?" (John 14:8-14)

In the face of the protests of the Jewish scholars, Jesus repeatedly speaks of God as his Father. In the Garden of Gethsemane, he uses the Aramaic familiar form "Abba" ("Papa"). God is his Father, the definitive sign of which is Jesus' birth to a Virgin. Notwithstanding the good care provided by Saint Joseph, who is his legal father and truly a father to Jesus, nevertheless, his origin is not from Saint Joseph but from God.

Here's the Good News: through Baptism, we too become children of God! We become adopted children of God the Father. For this reason, we too can speak with the same boldness in prayer that Jesus had. "If you ask anything in my name," he says, "I will do it." I mentioned last week the priest's introduction to the Lord's Prayer in the Mass of the Roman Rite, which dates back to the time of Saint Gregory the Great: Praeceptis salutaribus moniti et divina institutione formati, audemus dicere —"at the savior's command, and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say." We dare to say! The priest is imploring us to consider the audacity of these words, in which we call upon God as Father. We do this, as Saint Paul teaches, because he has given us the Holy Spirit, by which we cry "Abba! Father!" From this point, Saint Paul goes on to one of his great crescendos: "So you are no longer a slave, but a Son. And if a Son, then also an heir: heirs with God, joint heirs with Christ" (cf. Gal 4:7).

God is our Father, the Father we claim as members of the Body of Christ. That makes the Lord's prayer inherently ecclesial. In other words, I pray not as an isolated individual but as a member of a Body, the Church. For this reason, when I pray I am never alone, even if no one is physically present, because we pray to the Father in union with the whole Church.

To pray the Lord's Prayer sincerely requires a renunciation of self. It means rejecting the deadly sin of pride and self-sufficiency in which I call the shots and set my own path in life. Don't those early chapters of Genesis—the Fall, the murder, the flood, the Tower—show us the perennial truth that when we choose what we want instead of what God wants, it only ever leads to misery? Instead, we must put aside whatever misconceptions we have, ask for healing from whatever wounds we carry, and abandon ourselves into the hands of the Father who knows how to give good gifts, who never abandons us, and who gives us true freedom.

May the Lord grant you peace!




