I believe this transition provides an excellent opportunity for us to renew and strengthen the Catholic identity of our school by genuinely committing to becoming Passionately Catholic and Academically Excellent.

We want our children to have a solid Catholic moral foundation. We must work together as a team of reverent, respectful, and responsible adults. As Catholics, we believe parents are the primary teachers of faith and morals. Your decision to send your child to Saint Mary Magdalen School communicates that you are willing to partner and promote our vision and values by living a life of virtue as a Catholic. Our goal together is that we all become saints and help each other by offering our time and talents.

This summer, we will form a search committee for a new principal for the 2023-24 school year. In the meantime, I ask that you respect and support the following changes to the school leadership for this the upcoming year.

Ms. Winterberger will become the Principal Emeritus. Her office will be within our parish office, and she will work closely with me to support the school and transition.

Mrs. Jennifer Roehrig, Vice Principal, has agreed to be the interim Principal during this transition, and she has recently completed her Archdiocesan Principal Program. Jennifer will assume complete authority over operations and the day-to-day of the school as principal.

Over the summer, **Kathleen Logan** will begin a two-year Master's program in Educational Leadership at the University of Notre Dame, and she will also begin the Archdiocesan Principal Training Program this September. To gain real-time practical experience, Kathleen has agreed to be the interim Vice-Principal as she continues to teach in our middle school.

To help solidify the school's Catholic Identity, **Fr. Jonathan** will be the spiritual director. He will work with **Deacon Joseph Boyle**, our new Director of Religious Education (DRE). They will collaborate with our faculty to teach religion and promote a love for prayer, Mass, adoration, and charity. We thank **Mrs. Dorothy Brown** for her time as DRE, and she will become our new music teacher in September.

To enable all of us to become better **Missionary Disciples of Jesus**, we are reviewing the existing disciplinary code for grades fourth through eighth. I am open to any recommendations you can offer.

I am most grateful to the **Home and School Association** for its leadership. They assure me of their willingness to provide more spiritual and social activities so that our school community enjoys learning and growing in friendship with Jesus and each other.

Additionally, we will add new members to our **School Board** to promote our school and increase enrollment. Our Finance Committee has approved a 3% increase to thank our school employees for their outstanding dedication this past year.

We are very grateful to those who participated in the recent Archdiocesan **Disciple Maker Index Survey (DMI)** and those who attended one of our four **Synod Sessions**. The formatted Synod Sessions provided a vital opportunity for all Catholics to respond to questions as the Body of the Church from the Holy See for discernment in preparation for the Bishops' Synod culminating in October 2023. In addition to the several Synod Sessions held in the St. Francis Room, we offered a session at Lima Estates and another for the school's faculty.

On Friday, May 20, we received the DMI Survey data results for our parish collected by the Catholic Leadership Institute. Together, both yield crucial feedback for our parish, Archdiocese, and the Universal Church. Under the guidance of Msgr. Chieffo, the Pastoral Council is currently at work to develop meaningful ways to share these insights and formulate essential opportunities to restore, enrich, and grow as a parish family.

Together with the Lord, we will continue to grow in sacrificial love and bear good fruit as passionate Catholics to enable us as His Missionary Disciples! We hope you join us where you are on your path as we continue our journey as a loving family of faith in Jesus Christ.

NEW! PREP MINISTRY NEWS

We thank all of our students and parents for another successful year.

The upcoming 2022-2023 plan is Monsignor Chieffo's design to best serve the religious education of children and families enrolled in the program. **The upcoming PREP format includes:**

- Classes are held in-person for all grades on the First and Third Sundays or First and Third Mondays, depending on grade level.
- All students and their families are expected to attend the Mass of their choosing each weekend.
- Beginning with the 9:30 AM Mass, our Sunday Classes are only for the second and seventh grades and continue after the Mass. The second-grade class will be in the school, and the seventh grade class will be held in either St. Francis Hall or the school. The Sunday dismissal is 11:45 AM.
- Monday classes will be held from 5 to 6 PM in the school for grades 1, 3, 4, 5, and 6.
- Parents will guide their children through the PREP lessons on the second and fourth weeks of each month.
- Catechists will provide reading and homework assignments for weeks two and four.
- Homeschool is an option for those preferring that format.
- At least one parent must attend each required monthly Parent Meeting on Tuesday evenings at 7 PM in the church (*with some exceptions, see the full schedule on PREP page of our website*).
- The 2022-23 Registration Deadline is Monday, August 15.

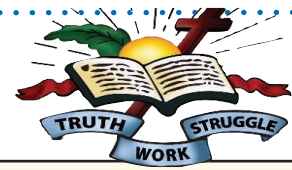

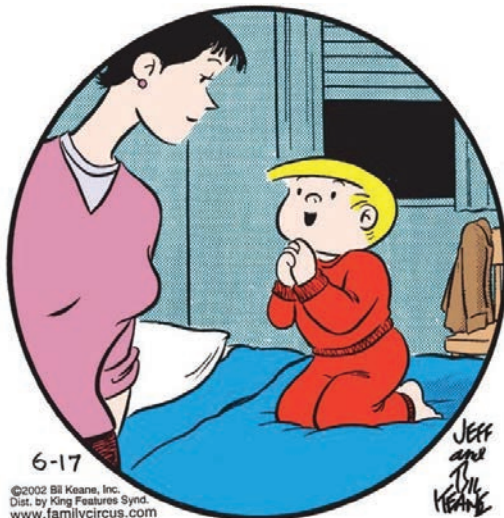
SMM ALUMNI NEWS
