THE FEAST OF ST. MARY MAGDALEN

Dear Faithful & Friends,

Praised be Jesus Christ! This weekend, we admire and honor Saint Mary Magdalen. The readings for Mass have a theme of determined search. We contemplate the devotion and witness of our patroness at the tomb on Easter Sunday, *"They have taken my Lord, and I don't know where they laid him"* (Jn 20:13).

We admire the perseverance of Mary Magdalen following Jesus and remaining at the cross. We admire her fidelity at the tomb. We admire her announcement to the disciples after encountering the risen Christ, *"I have seen the Lord [...]"* (Jn 20:18). We admire how our Lord blessed her perseverance, fidelity, and obedience by appearing to her before the others after His resurrection.

When we consider the life of Saint Mary Magdalen, we are invited to respond with faith, hope, and love. Our Lord worked powerfully in her life and can do the same for us. There are many ways we search for happiness. However, often times they are in trivial things. The example of our patroness reminds us to seek first the Kingdom of God.

The dynamic of Holy Mother Church being related to Almighty God is expressed by way of our First Reading from the book of the Song of Songs. The author describes the bride of Christ on the search for her bridegroom, *"I sought him but I did not find him. I will rise then and go about the city; in the streets and crossings I will seek Him whom my heart loves"* (Sg 3:2). The saints had a constant desire to seek out our good Lord. The psalmist reminds us, too, *"My soul is thirsting for you, O Lord my God."*

The search is not about a lack of information or location. Rather, it is the soul's desire to be united with Almighty God forever. The saints, after encountering Christ, sought to be with Him always. The Apostle Paul writes in the Letter to the Philippians, *"I have come to rate all as loss in the light of the surpassing knowledge of my Lord Jesus Christ. For His sake I have forfeited everything; I have accounted all else rubbish so that Christ may be my wealth"* (3:8).

Saint Mary Magdalen encountered Jesus, and her life was never the same. Since we are under her patronage, we should have the confidence to ask for her intercession with our Lord. Through the intercession of Saint Mary Magdalen, may we experience the light of faith in Jesus Christ. May you experience the desire to seek our Lord above all things and be privileged to deepen your encounter with Him. Our Lord tells us, *"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened"* (Mt 7:7-8).

As we contemplate the profound encounter of Mary Magdalen with our risen Lord at the tomb, can we see the parallel in a worthy Holy Communion? We are invited to encounter the same risen Lord in every Holy Communion. It is in a different mode of presence than that first Easter Sunday, but we are so blessed to find the same risen Christ on every Sunday throughout our lives.

Mary Magdalen recognizes Jesus only after He calls her by name and she responds, "Rabbouni," which means teacher. Saint Gregory the Great reflects on how fitting it is that she calls Him teacher, *"because the one whom she sought outwardly was the one who inwardly taught her to keep on searching"* (from a homily on the Gospels by Gregory the Great, pope). I know in the middle of July, nobody wants to think of teaching and school, but we are always being taught by our Lord to seek Him, like our beloved Mary Magdalen. Happy Feast!

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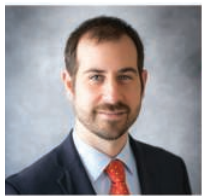


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
