THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Dear Friends in Christ,

Our lives have been briefly upended by the snowfall.

As I write this, our school is closed, and our campus is blanketed by beautiful but also inconvenient ice and snow.

As I was praying Morning Prayer in the quiet, empty chapel last Sunday morning, I laughed as I came upon Psalm 148:

*Práise the Lórd from the éarth,  
séa creatures and all óceans,  
fire and háil, snow and míst,  
stormy wínds that obéy his wórd;*

Fire and hail, snow and mist indeed! By praying this Psalm, the people of Israel were acknowledging God's sovereignty over creation. It's not that the elements or certainly human action have no effect on our lives and our history—they do! But God, the only God, is the ruler of them all. He allows those things to happen, and nothing escapes His gaze. This was a huge lesson for the people of Israel—they were used, like all the other nations, to see various gods as in charge of various elements of nature. Thus, it was necessary to worship Apollo so the sun would continue shining, Neptune so the sea would be calm, and all the rest. But the people of Israel came to understand that none of those gods—of the Egyptians or the Babylonians or the Greeks—were real. They were all deceptions—only their God was the true God, and He rules over everything. As Psalm 148 concludes:

*Let them práise the náme of the Lórd  
for he alóne is exálted.  
The spléndor of his náme  
réaches beyond héaven and éarth.*

*He exálts the stréngth of his péople.  
He is the práise of all his sáints,  
of the sóns of Ísrael,  
of the péople to whóm he comes clóse.*

God has come close to us—indeed, in Jesus Christ, He has come infinitely closer than even the Psalmist could have imagined. He has taken on our flesh and borne our sins in His own body. In the Eucharist, the perpetual memorial of Christ's sacrifice, which reconciles us to God, He continues to come close to us.

He rules over our lives like a gentle shepherd—comforting us, but also challenging us to entrust ourselves more perfectly to Him.

That's the hardest part, trusting that God really has our best interest at heart, that if we surrender ourselves more completely to Him, He will transform us "from glory to glory" (2 Cor 3:18). Often, this presents itself as a problem for us. We step back. We ignore the invitation to "put out into deep water" (Luke 5:4) and instead content ourselves with the false gods—not Venus or Zeus, but power, money, career success, and pleasant experiences. In these things, at least, there is a veneer of control and accomplishment. But in the end, they leave us empty unless we have surrendered ourselves to Christ and come, like Saint Paul, to measure everything from the perspective of His goodness and love.

Soon, the snow and ice will melt. Life will return to normal. But for a Christian, nothing can ever be the same once we have been made new by Baptism. The horizon of our lives must expand, and our hearts must take on God's way of viewing things. If we do that, then everything—even the difficult and unexpected moments—can become encounters with Christ and invitations to grow in His love, the love which, as Dante famously wrote, "moves the sun and the stars."

May the Lord grant you peace!

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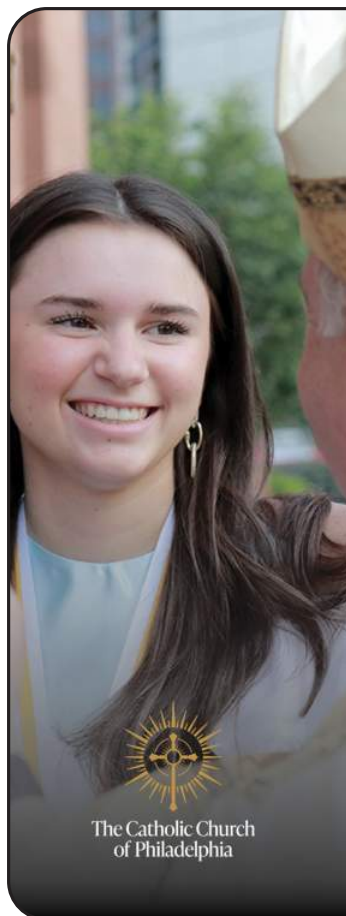

## KNIGHTS' SUPER BOWL BLOCK POOL FUNDRAISER

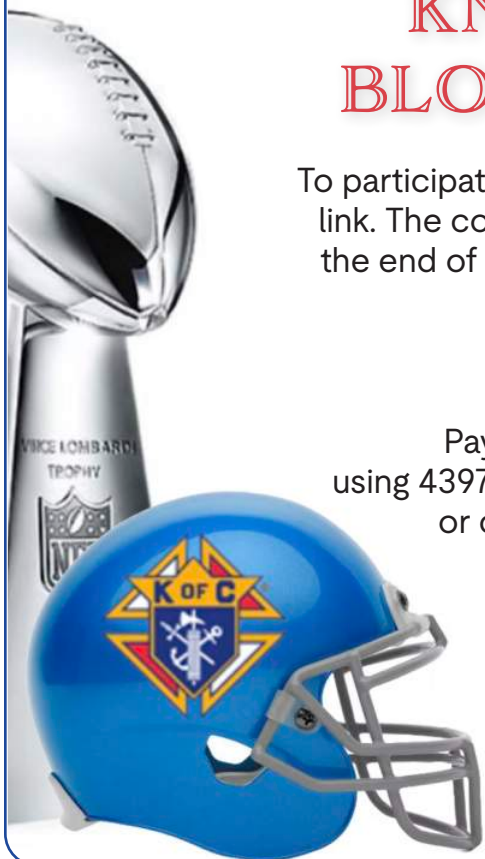

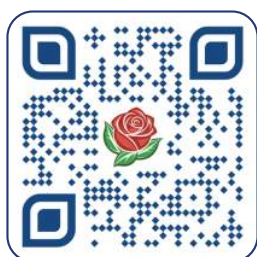
