One of the traditions surrounding the Epiphany is the announcement of the movable feasts for the year.

Traditionally, it is chanted right after the Gospel at Mass. Here is the text:

Know, dear brethren, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On February 18 will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On April 5, you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On May 14 will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On May 24, the feast of Pentecost.

On June 7, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On November 29, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever.

Amen.

For many people in our culture, Christmas ended weeks ago! But for us as Catholics, we are still instructed to rejoice at the good news of Christ's birth, news which was longed for and celebrated even by three star-gazers from a land far away from Israel.

Remember, the twelve days of Christmas do not end with Christmas; they begin with Christmas (!) and end on the Feast of the Epiphany, January 6 (for some strange reason, here in the United States, we shift this great Feast to the Sunday closest to January 6).

One way some families celebrate is by "chalking" their front doors on the Feast of the Epiphany. The way to do this is simple: take chalk of any color and write the following above the entrance of your home: 20 + C + M + B + 26. The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar — who came to visit Jesus in His first home. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, *Christus mansionem benedicat*: "May Christ bless the house."

The numbers at the beginning and end indicate the new year. The chalking takes place while this prayer is said, traditionally by the father of the family:

May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is your incarnate Word, now and forever. Amen.

God of heaven and earth, you revealed your only-begotten One to every nation by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the light of Christ, that our concern for others may reflect your love. We ask this through Christ our Saviour. Amen.

Loving God, bless this household. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness, and abiding in your will. We ask this through Christ our Saviour. Amen.

Then the house is sprinkled with Holy Water. We will have blessed chalk and holy water available in the narthex for you to take this weekend if you would like to make this tradition part of your family's celebration of Christmas and Epiphany.

May the Lord grant you peace in this new year and always!

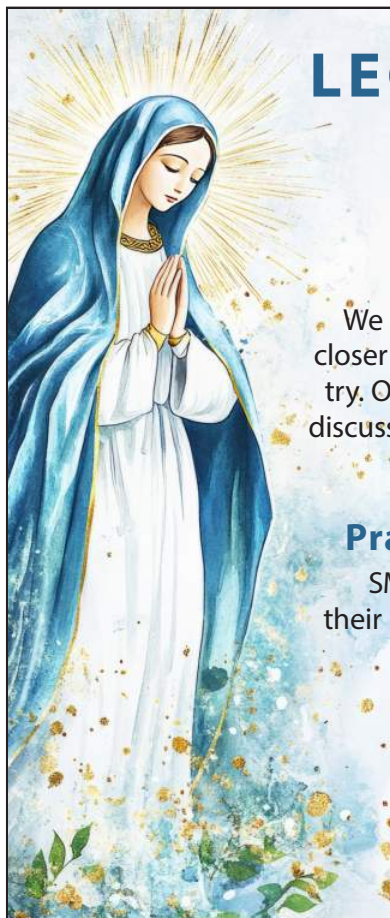

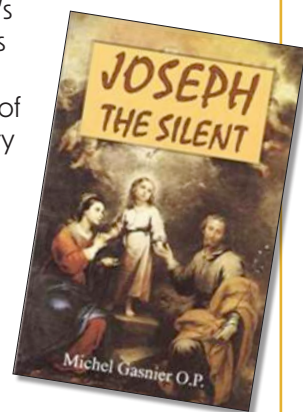
Dialogues

Join us for powerful, practical training in the habits and skills of missionary discipleship.

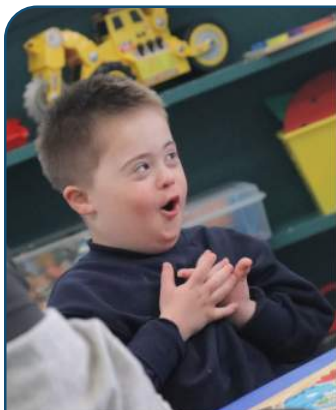
Part 1: The School of Discipleship, will help you grow deeper in personal friendship with Jesus through prayer and personal conversion.
