Dear Friends in Christ,

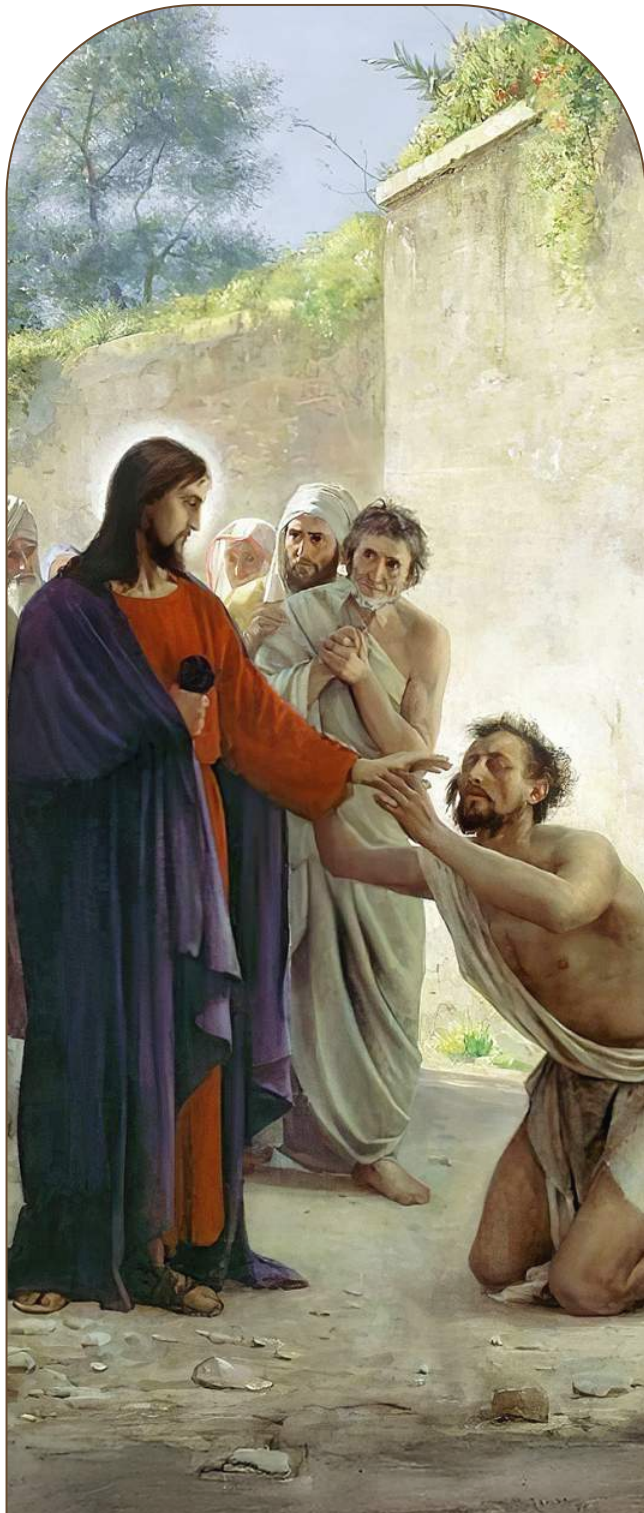
On the night before He died, Jesus gathered around Him the Twelve who had followed Him during His public ministry. They had witnessed the signs that no one else had ever seen; they heard His words about the Kingdom of God, which was even then being inaugurated. But on that night, gathered in a large, furnished upper room, Jesus anticipated and mysteriously began His own Passover by instituting the Eucharistic mystery, in which He handed on to the Church for all time His own body and blood, the perpetual memorial of His passion and death. We celebrate this event in a special way each year on Holy Thursday, but it takes place sacramentally every time we gather for the Eucharist.

We have an incomparable treasure in that, in our parish church, Christ dwells at all times among His people in the Blessed Sacrament. Our adoration chapel allows people to pray before the Blessed Sacrament almost all week, which is a beautiful gift. Recently, a gentleman who is not a parishioner found out who I was and thanked our parish for providing this service of an open chapel for so many hours each week. Indeed, it is a special gift we offer to the community by having parishioners serve as adorers. For this reason, we are constantly in need of more people who commit to an hour each week in this powerful ministry of prayer and presence before the all-holy one who is present to us in the Eucharistic mystery.

Before we know it, summer will be here. This is a time when people go away, and our schedules shift. Therefore, it is important that we have as many people as possible sign up for an adoration slot so that we can maintain the current hours (Monday 9 AM - Friday 1 PM) for the summer months as well.

You will recall that the Church has laid down clearly that exposition may not take place unless at least two people are present. In addition, during

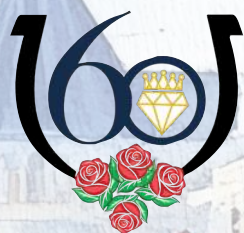

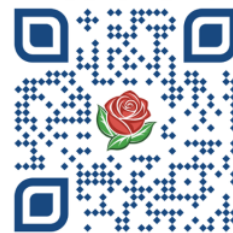
