FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Resurrect in the Sacraments of Reconciliation and the Eucharist



What is the significance of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead? It was more than a miraculous event. It is a “sign” of God’s promise to raise all who have died in Christ to everlasting life. That is why Jesus asked Martha if she believed in the resurrection of the dead. Our Catholic Creed culminates in the proclamation of the resurrection of the dead on the last day and to life everlasting. Saint Paul proclaims what our faith and hope are, saying, “If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit which dwells in you” (*Romans 8:11*). Through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, God’s Powerful Spirit (*GPS*) guarantees us new life and love in Christ Crucified but Risen.

Lazarus means, ‘God is my help,’ and through his sickness and subsequent death, God brought glory through his Son, the Lord Jesus, who raised Lazarus from the dead in anticipation of his own death and resurrection. Even now, we can experience the power of the Resurrection of the Lord Jesus in our lives. The Holy Spirit is ever ready to change and transform us into men and women of faith, hope, and love. Do you believe that the power of Jesus’ resurrection is at work in your life today? Let the Holy Spirit strengthen within you the vibrancy and joy of God and the hope of heaven by receiving the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

Our participation in the Lord’s Supper in the Eucharist already gives us a foretaste of Jesus’ transfiguration of our bodies. Saint Irenaeus teaches us: “Just as bread that comes from the earth, after God’s blessing has been invoked upon it, is no longer ordinary bread, but Eucharist, formed of two things, the one earthly and the other heavenly: so too our bodies, which partake of the Eucharist, are no longer corruptible but possess the hope of resurrection” (*Adv. Haeres. 4,18*).

Psalm 27 ends with the great prayer of hope in the resurrection: “I believe that I shall see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living! Wait for the Lord; be strong, and let your heart take courage; yes, wait for the Lord!” Do you find joy and hope in the resurrection of Jesus Christ? Lord Jesus Christ, you have ransomed us with your blood and restored us to life with the Father in heaven. May your resurrection be our hope as we long to enjoy your glorious face as your saints.

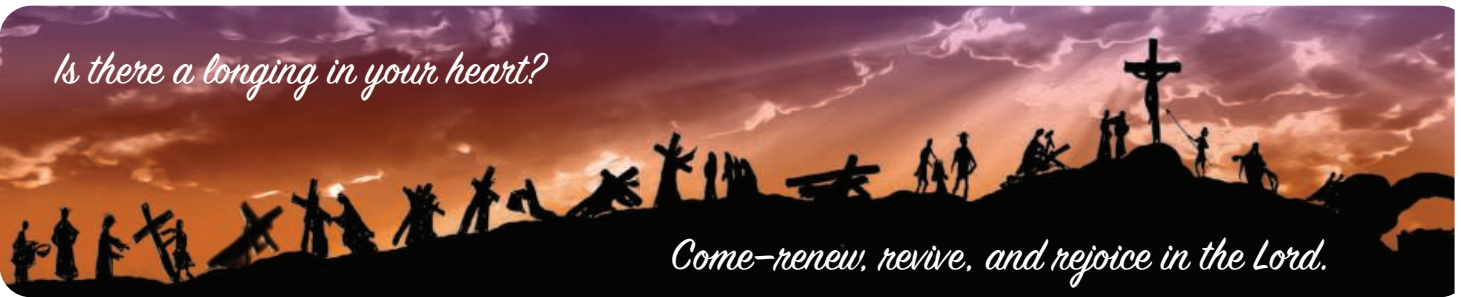

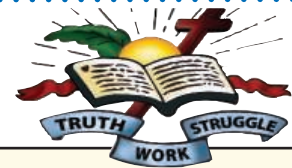

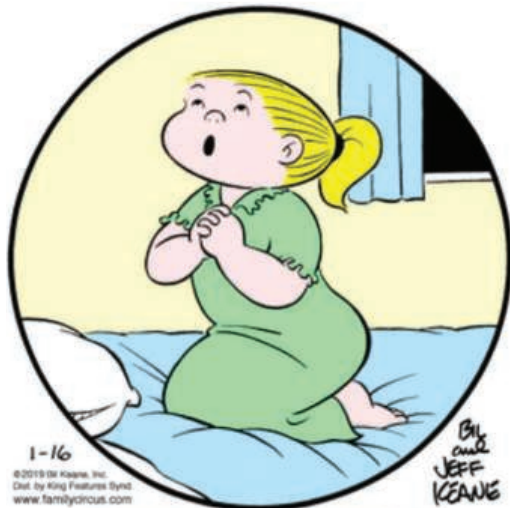
