The Grace of the Seven Sacraments

Baptism, Part One

Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

June 30, 2024



Dear Friends in Christ,

Thank you for the wonderful welcome you have given me in these last couple of weeks. It has been a joy to get to meet so many of you at Mass and at other parish activities. I trust that the Holy Spirit will continue to act powerfully among us—may we ask for the grace to respond!

I would like to use these bulletin letters as an opportunity to offer a few points of teaching which can be difficult to fit into a 5 to 7 minute homily. I hope you will find it helpful. Today, I'd like to start a series on the seven sacraments, the means by which the Holy Spirit acts in the world so that the grace of salvation can be communicated to each person. I'd like to start—where else? With Baptism.

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20).

These words from the end of Matthew's Gospel have echoed in the hearts of Christian believers since that day of Ascension. Our tradition calls these words the "Great Commission."

Saint Matthew records these words as Jesus' final instructions. He is at the mountain with the Eleven, about to ascend to the Father, from whom he had come. Now, the mission of the Spirit will be to extend in time and space the victory which was accomplished in the Paschal Mystery.

This Great Commission begins with the powerful word: "Go." At the end of Mass, the priest or deacon tells everyone to "Go forth," or "Go in peace," or "Go, and announce the Gospel of the Lord." We "go" out of ourselves, sometimes out of our comfort zones. But we trust that we are sent by Christ and that we are buoyed up by the Spirit. This allows us to leave the friendly confines of the Liturgy to bring Christ's message to the world.

This "go"-ing out leads to making disciples for Christ. A disciple is not one who is perfect. Rather, a disciple is a learner. The enemy of our human nature wants us to think that we have to be perfect to announce to others the message of Christ. I'm too broken; my life is messy; there is still sin in my life. Those may all be true—but Jesus certainly didn't choose his disciples because they were perfect. Their many faults so visible in the Gospels should make that clear. All we need to be a missionary disciple is to believe that Christ's liberation from sin and death is the greatest message that anyone will ever hear.

Jesus instructs the Eleven to baptize in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, a tradition which has continued from the time of the Apostles to this very day. Over the course of the year, dozens of infants will be brought to our baptismal font at St. Mary Magdalen to become new members of the family of God. How awesome it would be if we could have dozens of adults receiving this gift of salvation at the Easter Vigil as well! This is something worth praying for in an intentional way.

Pope Francis has emphasized the importance of baptism in the Christian life. Within our communities, baptism helps us to recognize our equality as members of the Body of Christ. The youngest infant, the newest convert, the person who does not come to Church, and the Pope—all of these share our common baptism. We must treat them all with reverence as brothers and sisters in Christ. When we build each other up, that's what we are doing: helping each other live out our baptism with greater fervor.

Baptism also unites us with our brothers and sisters who share our Christian faith but are not in full communion with the Catholic Church. I am sure that all of us know Protestants or Orthodox Christians. Though it is important to recognize our disagreements, we can never forget the Baptism which unites us all.

How could we ever expect to live out this Great Commission? The last words of Jesus in Saint Matthew's Gospel should answer that question for us in a definitive way: "And behold, I am with you always, until the close of the age" (Mt 28:20). This is the promise and hope which sustains us as we seek to live the grace of Baptism we have received.

May the Lord grant you peace!

NEW! A MISSIONARY DREAM FOR ALL PARISHES

—Pope Francis, Apostolic Exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium* (27-28)

"I dream of a 'missionary option', that is, a missionary impulse capable of transforming everything, so that the Church's customs, ways of doing things, times and schedules, language, and structures can be suitably channeled for the evangelization of today's world rather than for her self-preservation. The renewal of structures demanded by pastoral conversion can only be understood in this light: as part of an effort to make them more mission-oriented, to make ordinary pastoral activity on every level more inclusive and open, to inspire in pastoral workers a constant desire to go forth and in this way to elicit a positive response from all those whom Jesus summons to friendship with himself. As John Paul II once said to the Bishops of Oceania: 'All renewal in the Church must have mission as its goal if it is not to fall prey to a kind of ecclesial introversion.'

The parish is not an outdated institution; precisely because it possesses great flexibility, it can assume quite different contours depending on the openness and missionary creativity of the pastor and the community. While certainly not the only institution which evangelizes, if the parish proves capable of self-renewal and constant adaptivity, it continues to be 'the Church living in the midst of the homes of her sons and daughters.' This presumes that it really is in contact with the homes and the lives of its people, and does not become a useless structure out of touch with people or a self-absorbed group made up of a chosen few. The parish is the presence of the Church in a given territory, an environment for hearing God's word, for growth in the Christian life, for dialogue, proclamation, charitable outreach, worship and celebration. In all its activities the parish encourages and trains its members to be evangelizers. It is a community of communities, a sanctuary where the thirsty come to drink in the midst of their journey, and a centre of constant missionary outreach. We must admit, though, that the call to review and renew our parishes has not yet sufficed to bring them nearer to people, to make them environments of living communion and participation, and to make them completely mission-oriented."


We Pray: Holy Spirit, breathe on us and renew within us the fullness of life and the strength to defend it.
