Dear Friends of Saint Mary Magdalen School,

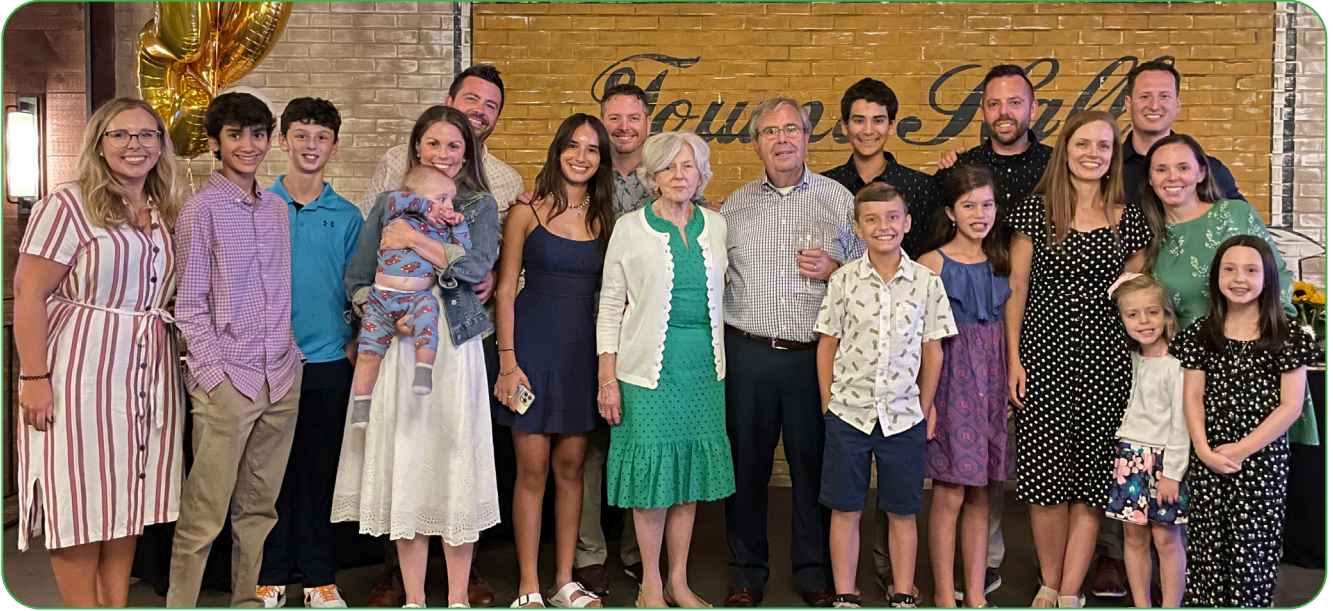

PAT MINISZAK

The word 'family' is defined "as a group of persons of common ancestry." Patricia Ann Miniszak, the only child of Ann and Peter Miniszak, learned early that this was not her parents' definition, which extended beyond the bounds of blood relatives. Her entire neighborhood became an extension of her family. If a neighbor needed anything, they were always welcome at the Miniszak home. Daily, through her parents' example, Pat learned that you must always be willing to help family, friends, and neighbors.

Patricia's education began at St. Robert's Parish School and continued at Notre Dame High School. The summer before her senior year, she expressed to her parents her desire to join the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. As a sister, she pursued further education at Trinity University and Towson University. Upon finishing her studies, she taught in New York, Pennsylvania, and Maryland. While in Maryland, she was appointed principal of Trinity Preparatory School. In 1973, Patricia decided to leave the Sisters of Notre Dame and began serving the church as a lay teacher. She was employed at St. Laurence Parish in Upper Darby for the next 15 years. During this time, her father suffered a massive stroke, and her mother was diagnosed with thyroid cancer. A friend suggested she teach at a parish closer to her parents' home, leading Patricia to accept a teaching position at St. Mary Magdalen. Another friend encouraged her to apply to Immaculata University to complete her Master's in Educational Leadership, which she did, and she also took additional classes to earn her Principal's Certification. In 1993, Patricia became the first lay principal at St. Mary Magdalen School.

When asked about her experiences, Pat reveals St. Mary Magdalen is an integral part of her family. The teachers, parents, students, and parishioners all hold a special place in her heart. The teachers and staff were dedicated, prepared, supportive, and willing to work as a team. Each morning, during prayers, the students embraced her challenge to be passionately Catholic, striving to deepen their relationship with God while committing themselves to achieving their best. The parents were cooperative, responsible, and eager to contribute their time and talents. After overseeing three Middle States Evaluations and serving on the committee to build the new church in 2008, Pat decided it was time to retire as principal. However, Msgr. Ralph had other plans for her. She was named president of the school on a voluntary, part-time basis, a role she maintained until 2013. Following that, she served as the Alumni Coordinator until 2018.

During her years in education, Patricia received the following awards: in 1987, she was awarded The Distinguished Catholic Educator Award by the Archdiocese of Philadelphia; in 2006, The Distinguished Elementary Administrator Award from the Office of Catholic Education; and in 2007, "Woman of the Year" from St. Francis Country Home for her leadership in Catholic Education. The Little Sisters of the Poor presented her with the St. Jeanne Jugan Award in 2015 for her generosity, leadership, and encouragement of others to assist and support Holy Family Home.

Still actively embracing her SMM family, Pat belongs to two parish prayer groups, is a board member of the Seniors' Social Club, and attends the 8:30 daily Mass with a close community of friends.

Patricia Miniszak has shared that she enjoyed her 54 years in Catholic education and loved every minute, even the few challenging ones. She feels incredibly blessed that the Lord guided her to SMM. During her interview, when Pat saw the "Statue of Our Lady of the Smile," she knew this was where God wanted her to be. She trusted in God, and in return, He provided her with many wonderful people she considers part of her family, the strength to do her job, and many surprises over the last forty years at SMM!

With the encouragement of Msgr. Ralph, they embarked on a deeper and more vibrant journey in their faith at SMM. Larry and Jean became active members of the parish Pre-Cana Group. Additionally, Larry was invited to join the Parish Finance Committee, where he has served for over 15 years.

Larry had been a member of the Knights of Columbus since his college days. When Council #14982 was established at St. Mary Magdalen Parish in March 2010, he transferred his membership to that Council. After retiring as Chief Operating Officer at First Priority Bank, Larry became an active member of the SMM Council, serving as Grand Knight for 4 years and currently serving as a Trustee.

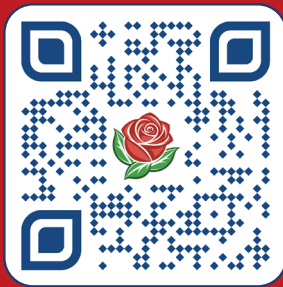

He then took on the role of Vice Chair and has been the Chairman of the Board for the past six years. In his capacity as Chairman, he also participates on the Endowment Committee's Board.

During their retirement, they enjoy spending time traveling, enjoying family and friends while continuing their spirit of service in the our parish and community.

HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHTS



On June 4, 1963, Archbishop John J. Krol established Saint Mary Magdalen Parish to serve 143 families in the Rose Tree-Marple Newtown area. In the beginning, the community utilized temporary quarters in the neighborhood for clergy and as a chapel while construction of more permanent buildings took place. Work on a rectory and a combined chapel and school began in April 1965. The parish buildings are on 12.7 acres that were formerly part of "El Rancho," or the Fetterman farm.



The founding pastor, Rev. Gilbert J. McDevitt, J.C.D., announced the school's opening in September 1965 and on November 8, 1965, the doors were officially opened. The first building included a chapel, a sacristy, four classrooms, and an office. By 1970, the first church was completed, and the school building was expanded to create individual classrooms for each grade. A library and an auditorium were also incorporated.



Sister Mary Kathleen O.P., the founding principal, served from 1965 to 1984. In 1984, Sister Mary Immaculate Doyle, O.P., succeeded her. Like many schools in the Archdiocese, the school's religious faculty was gradually replaced by lay teachers. In September 1993, Miss Patricia Miniszak became the first lay principal overseeing a completely lay faculty. In September 2008, Pat was named the first president, and Mrs. Barbara Burke became the fourth principal, serving until June 2015. Mrs. Mary Anne Johnston joined the staff as vice principal in September 2013 and later served as president until June 2015. Our fifth principal, Ms. Denise Winterberger, served from 2015 to 2022 and then held the title of principal emeritus during the 2022-23 school year, while vice-principal Mrs. Jennifer Roehrig served as interim principal. On July 1, 2023, the school was pleased to announce its sixth principal, Mrs. Amy Crawford Bauer, and Deacon Joseph Boyle was named as its third president.



Since its founding, the school has made many changes to adapt to the evolving needs of our community. Each year, we are blessed to have alumni parents return to enroll their children at SMM. Today, our parish has over 5,500 members, and it remains focused on the future with high expectations for our school. We are committed to building upon the strong foundations and standards established at St. Mary Magdalen, which will continue to provide students with an academically excellent Catholic education.

St. Mary Magdalen School is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, which is a recognized accrediting agency in the State of Pennsylvania. Our school is also a member of the National Catholic Educational Association.

Under the guidance of Msgr. Chieffo and in an effort to continue to strengthen the foundations of the school for its current and future families, a Board of Limited Jurisdiction was formed on December 15, 2015. Mike Rinaldi was named its first president but was relocated due to work in 2016. Bill Robinson took over afterwards, until Larry Donato became its third and current president in 2020.



In 2018, St. Mary Magdalen School was named as a National Blue Ribbon School, the highest award given by the United States Department of Education. In 2019, 2022, 2023, and 2024, the school received the Archdiocese of Philadelphia's Distinguished Instruction Award based on the results of the Terra Nova test scores. The school achieved these recognitions because 96% of our 3rd through 8th-grade students met or exceeded the anticipated scores for their grade levels in every subject area. Additionally, 85% of our students demonstrated at least one full year of growth in their learning.



Our school participates in the Connelly Foundation's Neumann Scholars program since it was initiated in 1995. This program identifies academically talented eighth-grade students within the parochial school system through an independently administered examination, and it provides four-year scholarships to attend one of the Archdiocesan high schools. Since its inception, our school has had 39 Neumann Scholars who have received and accepted this honor, including a record six students from our Class of 2020, the highest number from one school class in the history of the scholarship.
