Dear Friends in Christ,



If you've ever had the opportunity to visit Lourdes in Southern France, you know that on the surface, it is just one of so many resort towns along the French countryside. Though a place of simple farmers and laborers in the 19th century, today it fills up in the winter with skiers who enjoy the beautiful hills. But, of course, this tiny, unimportant town was made famous the world over thanks to the mysterious appearance of a lady dressed in white to a young peasant girl named Bernadette.

Bernadette's family lived in extreme poverty due to various circumstances. And yet, isn't this always the way with our Lady?

Juan Diego, Bernadette, the tres pastorinhos of Fatima: again and again, the Mother of God reminds us that God's way of measuring the importance of people is so different from our own. The Kingdom of God belongs first and foremost to the poor, the suffering, and the sick. To the rich, the well-fed, and the strong, the Kingdom is open only by exception—that is, only to those who are ready to admit their own poverty, their own lowliness, and their own sickness.

From the day that the mysterious lady who spoke of herself as the Immaculate Conception to now, hundreds of miracles (verified by medical experts) have been attributed to the water of Lourdes. How many countless more miracles of faith—of confessions long delayed, of pilgrims rejoicing at arriving at the goal of their wanderings—have taken place there over the years? Even as that part of Europe has seen untold suffering from wars and mass apostasy from the Christian faith in the last century, still Lourdes and its mystery continues.

When I was there a few years ago, the annual French military pilgrimage to Lourdes was taking place. Military units representing every division of the French armed forces, along with soldiers from many other nations, were present. How powerful it was to see all these soldiers in full uniform marching through the square during the evening rosary procession! And how lively the town was after—well past the time when I would have preferred to go to bed.

And at the same time, something unique was happening. There is a tradition (I don't know when it started) that

catechumens in the French military not be baptized at the Easter Vigil, but in Lourdes at the annual military pilgrimage on the weekend of Pentecost. That weekend I happened to be there—2024—nearly 180 catechumens were baptized, confirmed, and made their first communion. That was a record number of baptisms, and part of a trend of a very small but very real rebirth of Catholicism among young adults in what was once called “the eldest daughter of the Church.”

That miracle of faith—of the re-emergence of missionary zeal, of the receptivity of the Gospel among a generation awash in cultural malaise—surely is greater than any physical healing attributed to Lourdes in the last 170 years.

This past Wednesday—February 11th, the Memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes—the Church celebrated “World Day of the Sick,” an opportunity for us to recall the needs of those around us who are sick and the many others who care for them. This coming Wednesday—February 18th—is Ash Wednesday, when each of us comes forward and confesses our need for something greater than physical healing: the spiritual enlightenment which comes only from Christ, who was born among us in time, suffered on the Cross for our salvation, and rose from the dead so that we too might rise with Him. This Lent, we undertake that journey with Him anew. What healing are we looking for? What miracle of faith does Christ want to accomplish for us this year?

May the Lord grant you peace!

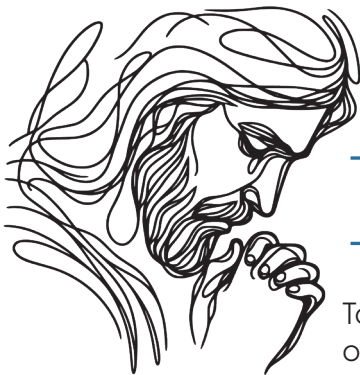
