SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Friends in Christ,

"Peace be with you:" these were the words of Jesus to the twelve apostles on that first day of the week, the evening in which they rejoiced with inexpressible joy that, despite everything, Christ our hope is alive, and so we too rise again with him. Through Baptism, the reign of sin is ended in us, and we come to share in the glorious resurrection of Christ, who steps into our families and hearts anew this Easter, just as he did on the evening of the resurrection, and says, "Peace be with you."

At the same time, in this Octave of Easter, I want to make an announcement that is not an easy one for me to make.

Today, Tuesday, April 7th, it was announced to the priests of the Archdiocese that Archbishop Pérez has appointed me Vicar General and Moderator of the Curia of the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, effective June 15th. While I did not in any way seek out such an appointment and was aware of my many shortcomings, I accepted it in a spirit of obedience.

In this role, I will serve as a member of the Archbishop's senior staff and advise him on the spiritual and temporal governance of the Archdiocese (effectively serving as something like a Chief of Staff) with specific responsibilities for financial, administrative, and priest personnel matters as outlined in the *Code of Canon Law*.

When I first learned of the Archbishop's intention, I was shocked. My first thoughts turned to all of you, the good people of Saint Mary Magdalen Parish. In my time here—which in the end will be much briefer than I expected—I have experienced the faithfulness, generosity, and warmth that have characterized this parish for so many years. There is truly a joyful spirit here, the surest sign of the presence of the Holy Spirit.

Archbishop Pérez will appoint a new pastor of Saint Mary Magdalen, and that announcement will be made in the middle of May. Until June 15th, I will remain here as pastor, as there is much to be done between now and then! The Archbishop is taking great care to select a priest who will be able to step in day one and continue the work of forming missionary disciples, celebrating the sacraments with reverence, and proclaiming the Gospel with joy at Mass, in the classrooms, and in many other ways.

There will be much more to say in the coming weeks, but let me conclude this note by saying what you already know: that the work of the Church is far bigger than any one person. As Saint Paul wrote to the Corinthian community:

What is Apollos, after all, and what is Paul? Ministers through whom you became believers, just as the Lord assigned each one. I planted, Apollos watered, but God caused the growth. Therefore, neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who causes the growth. The one who plants and the one who waters are equal, and each will receive wages in proportion to his labor. For we are God's co-workers; you are God's field, God's building (1 Cor 3:5-9).

As we enter this period of transition, I have every confidence that Saint Mary Magdalen Parish, this beautiful temple built of living stones, will grow and thrive in the years ahead. I pray for all of you daily and will continue to do so. Please pray for me.

May the Lord grant you peace!
