# Divine Love: The Fire That Moves All of Us



"God is Love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him" (1 Jn 4:16). Thus, opens the first encyclical of the late Benedict XVI, Deus Caritas Est. From the apostle John, we receive a summary of Christian life: "We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us."

Last week our beloved second graders and many of their parents had the opportunity to experience God's love through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The immense joy could be seen on their faces as they left the church transformed by an encounter with Jesus himself. In the words of the late pope: "Being Christian is...the encounter with an event, a person,

which gives life a new horizon and a decisive direction." That person is Jesus Christ.

During this Lenten season, our catechumens and candidates prepare to receive their sacraments at Easter. They enter the last stage of their preparation to participate fully in the life of the Church, which begins a lifetime relationship with Jesus. For us also, Lent is a time to rediscover our baptism. Most learn about our faith in Catechism, yet the Lord invites us not just to learn about Him but to know Him personally and intimately.

St. Mary Magdalen's community has ideal opportunity to encounter this person of Jesus Christ, this Divine love, through various Catechesis during the season of Lent. These Catechesis are part of "an itinerary of Catholic formation valid for our society and our time" (St. John Paul II). This itinerary has taken place in parishes worldwide for the past sixty years and has been supported and blessed by the last five popes.

On a personal note, my life has been changed drastically by this Catechesis. I listened to them in Colorado at the age of 13. At the time, I was trapped in various vices, angry with my family and myself, and I could not see the purpose of living. What was missing was an encounter with the person, Jesus, who came through the "foolishness of the preaching" to tell me that God loved me exactly the way I was and called me to a great mission.

Please join me, **John and Bernadette Brokers**, **Sean and Chiara Nieves**, and **Stella Ndossi** as we humbly pass on to you what we have received. We will have various talks **Mondays and Thursdays during Lent** at 7:30 PM in the St. Francis Room (see page 4). All ages 13 and older are welcome to come and listen. Free childcare is also available. Come to one, come to all—it doesn't matter. What is important is that we move toward and fall in love with the divine person of Jesus Christ, who wants to set us on fire with His Love.

# THIS WEEK! THE KINGDOM OF GOD IS AT HAND MONDAY & THURDAY EVENINGS

Archbishop Pérez said, "Christ's last Word to us was not to 'come' but to 'go." This call to be missionary disciples is essential because our call is to get everyone out of the pews and announce the Good News of Jesus Christ. We follow the kerygma to proclaim, as St. Peter did on Pentecost, after curing the Paralytic (Acts 2: 14-21). The Gospel implores us to remember our neighbors because we are to be a light to those in darkness and those who are lost. Anyone who does not know the love of Jesus Christ is lost in the dark.

We have all wanted to reach out and bring our children, relatives, friends, and even ourselves closer to Christ. As His disciples, we regularly pray about this but often struggle with what to do or say to change our relationships with God.

# Do This in Remembrance of Me

## The Mass-Part Four

Now that we have reminded ourselves of our Baptism, given reverence to Jesus present in the Tabernacle, and said quiet prayers of preparation, we are ready to stand for the Introductory Rites. For most parishes, these rites will begin with a hymn or the Entrance Antiphon. Undoubtedly, everyone has their "special way" of singing during the Mass. So, whether we sing quietly or belt out the lyrics, together, we offer our praises and raise our voices with one heart full of joy to the Lord!



Why do we do what we do at Mass? Over the coming weeks, in this multi-part bulletin series, we will explore the most common things Catholics know or want to know about the gift of the Mass.

## Let us Pray with a Song

Why do we sing? Looking back on our history and the Jewish roots of our liturgy, we see that music and singing are essential parts of our prayer together. Singing is one of the most fitting praises for God since it involves the body and soul even more than speaking (Singing is a lot more work).

When we sing, we use our whole beings to praise God. The *General Instruction for the Roman Missal* explains the importance: "The Christian faithful who come together as one in expectation of the Lord's coming are instructed by the **Apostle Paul** to sing together Psalms, hymns, and spiritual canticles (*Col 3:16*). Singing is the sign of the heart's joy (*Acts 2:46*). **St. Augustine** says rightly, 'Singing is for one

**St. Augustine** says rightly, 'Singing is for one who loves,' and there is also the ancient proverb: 'Whoever sings well prays twice over.'"

Our Musical Director **Ralph Purri** certainly agrees! So given all these reasons "Great importance should therefore be attached to the use of singing in the celebration of the Mass" (GIRM, no. 40).

At the beginning of Mass, the Entrance Hymn or Entrance Antiphon is "to open the celebration, foster the unity of those gathered, introduce their thoughts to the mystery of the liturgical time or festivity, and accompany the procession of the priest and ministers" (GIRM, no. 47). The Entrance Hymn helps us set aside everything else that is going on in our lives and prepares our hearts to praise God and participate in the Mass.

Singing together reminds us that we are a community because it is the first act we all do together at the Mass.

## "Be not afraid!"

Often one might be overheard or say to themselves, "I feel self-conscious because my voice is terrible!" However, Fr. Luke Spannagel declares, "to quote our Lord, Pope St. John Paul II, and many others: "Be not afraid!" God gave you the voice you have, and in singing praise to him, you are offering those gifts (or lack thereof) he gave you."

So, pick up that hymnal, find your key and join in!

## Reflection

Reflect on your participation at Mass as an opportunity to fulfill the exhortation of **Psalm 96**:

"Sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth. Sing to the Lord, bless his name; proclaim his salvation day after day." (Ps. 96:1-2)

Considering, the Old and New Testament offer many examples of individuals responding in songs, or "Canticles," to God's saving action, such as Moses and Miriam (Ex. 15:1-21), Moses (Dt. 32:1-44), Hannah (1 Sm. 2:1-10), David (1 Chr. 29:10-13), Tobit (Tb. 13:1-8), Judith (Jdt. 16:13-17), Sirach (Sir. 1:1-13).

Meditate on a scriptural Canticle and see how God moves you to respond.


