Dear Faithful & Friends,

Praised be Jesus Christ! *The Book of Psalms* is a window into the wide range of human experience and emotion in this life. Throughout this book we move from moments of profound awe to agonizing lamentation.

Psalm 145, our Responsorial Psalm for Mass today, is a great hymn of personal and royal praise to Almighty God. It serves as an introductory bridge to *Psalms 146-150*, often called the "Final Hallel," bringing the *Book of Psalms* to its climactic conclusion. The Psalter is divided into five sections; each section ends with a hymn of praise, or doxology. However, at the end of the entire Psalter, there is a succession of five hallel ("praise") psalms that reinforces the reality of the everlasting praise offered to Almighty God.

In verses 15-16 of *Psalm 145*, we pray: "The eyes of all look hopefully to you, and you give them their food in due season; you open your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing." The theme of divine providence provides a compelling reason to praise our Lord. In our Gospel (*Mt 14:13-21*), Jesus pities the crowds and miraculously provides for them through the multiplication of the five loaves and two fish.

Some dismiss this miracle by asserting that our Lord merely inspired the crowd to share what they already had. However, that is not how the Church has understood this Gospel. Rather, as the psalm inspires us to proclaim, "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs" (*cf. Ps 145:16*).

The Bible invites us to consider the source of all things, visible and invisible. We live under the care of a powerful, merciful, and generous God. We are called to be a people of faith who entrust all our needs to our Eternal Father through Christ. Yet, in the depth of His divine wisdom, Almighty God not only provides for us but also allows us to participate in His loving care for others.

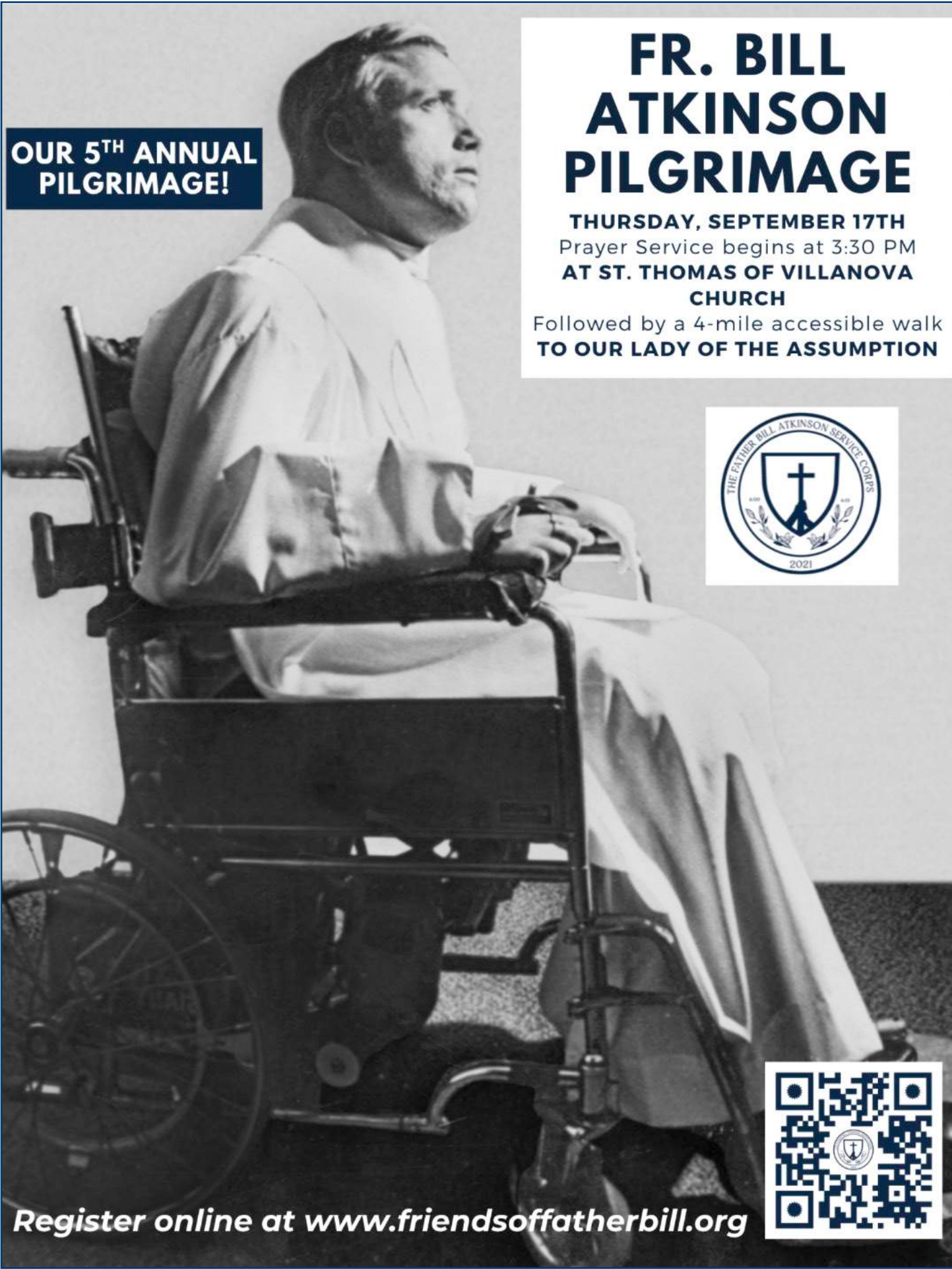

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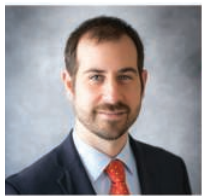
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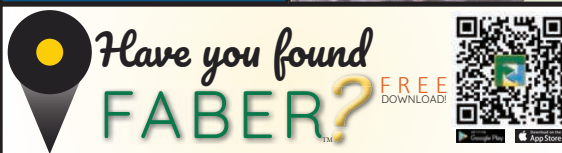


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
