

Do you know the mercy and joy of believing in the Risen Lord? Even after the apostles saw the empty tomb and heard the reports of Jesus' appearance to the women, they were still weak in faith and fearful of being arrested by the Jewish authorities. When Jesus appeared to them, he offered proof of his resurrection by showing them the wounds of his passion, his pierced hands, and his side. He calmed their fears and brought them peace, the peace that reconciles sinners and makes them friends of God.

While Thomas deeply loved the Lord, he lacked the courage to stand with Jesus in his passion and crucifixion. After Jesus' death, Thomas made the mistake of withdrawing from the other apostles. He sought isolation rather than fellowship in his time of trial and adversity. As Thomas finally had the courage to rejoin the other apostles, the Lord Jesus made his presence known and reassured Thomas that he had overcome death and risen again.

When Thomas recognized his Master, he believed and exclaimed that Jesus was indeed Lord and truly God!

As Missionary Disciples of Jesus, we need more than just belief; we need faith and courage to live and proclaim the Gospel of mercy in the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus did something that only love and trust can do. He commissioned his weak and timid apostles to bring the Good News of the Gospel to the ends of the earth. The sending out of the disciples parallels the sending out of Jesus by his heavenly Father. Jesus fulfilled his mission through perfect love and obedience to the will of his Father.

He called his first disciples and now calls each of us to do the same. Just as Jesus gave his first disciples the gift of the Holy Spirit, he breathed on each of us with the same Holy Spirit, equipping us with new life, power, joy, and courage to live each day as his followers. Let us be inspired by their example and motivated by the power of the Holy Spirit within us.

With trust in God's Powerful Spirit, we can proclaim that Jesus is our personal Lord and our God. He died and rose so that we, too, might have new life in him. The Lord offers each of us new life in His Holy Spirit so that we may know him personally and walk in this new way of life through the power of his resurrection.

NEW! BUILDING HOLY FAMILIES

Parents trying to build holy families today are walking through a minefield. One false step and the family blows up. Surveys show that the best way to pass on faith is for both parents to practice the faith.

If we want our next generation to grow in holiness, we need the fidelity, mercy, kindness, and compassion of both our Blessed Mother and St. Joseph.

We need to pray to Holy Mary and St. Joseph.

Our Mother blesses us with eternal love, while Saint Joseph shows us how to provide, protect, and promote faith through devotion. When Joseph discovered Mary was expecting a child, he planned to divorce her quietly and not expose her to shame.

Being a man of devout faith, Joseph obeyed whatever God asked of him without question. When the angel came to Joseph in a dream and told him the truth, Joseph immediately and without question or concern took Mary as his wife. When the angel appeared again to tell him the family was in danger, he immediately left everything he owned, his family and friends, and fled to a strange country with his young wife and newborn. He waited in Egypt without question until the angel told him it was safe to return.

St. Joseph's trust in God's plan and his faithfulness and loyalty to Mary teach us how to be confident and courageous in building a culture of life. When

Dr. John J. and Dr. Margaret T. Clark were devoted Saint Mary Magdalen Parish members. The Clarks directed that a gift be made through their estate to endow scholarships for students who were members of Saint Mary Magdalen parish toward their post-secondary education.

Annually, the Saint Mary Magdalen Scholarship Committee selects one eligible student to receive a scholarship toward two (2) years of undergraduate tuition for their chosen college, university, or trade school. The scholarship is \$5,000 per year for up to two years.

Eligibility for this scholarship requires that the student attended Saint Mary Magdalen School or Saint Mary Magdalen PREP (Parish Religious Education Program).




