SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

These days between the two great solemnities of Ascension and Pentecost are truly the first and greatest novena—nine days of prayer in preparation for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Acts of the Apostles describes it in this way:

Then they returned to Jerusalem from the mount called Olivet, which is near Jerusalem, a sabbath day's journey away; and when they had entered, they went up to the upper room, where they were staying, Peter and John and James and Andrew, Philip and Thomas, Bartholomew and Matthew, James the son of Alphaeus and Simon the Zealot and Judas the son of James. All these, with one accord, devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers.

The apostles have just witnessed the Ascension of the Lord Jesus. They haven't even elected a replacement for Judas yet. But their first act is to pray. As Christians, that is our first priority: to pray. Naturally, not all of us are meant to pray for the same

length of time as, say, a Trappist monk. The contemplative vocation is very different from that of a parent, or even a parish priest. Yet, so often I, and perhaps you, save prayer as a kind of court of final appeal. When all other options have been exhausted, we decide to pray. But this must not be so! Our first duty is to pray, and only then can we be docile to the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives.

Importantly, they are gathered together in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus. I have in my office a copy of El Greco's depiction of *Pentecost*, the original of which is on display at the Prado Museum in Madrid. As seen on the cover—it is a beautiful but very unique piece. And right in the center is Mary, Mother of God and Mother of the Church. Her posture in this portrait demonstrates that she has spent her whole life as a privileged instrument of the Holy Spirit. Even though the apostles bear the authority of Christ to tend the sheep in his name, it is very clear that Mary is the true spiritual authority here. She teaches us how to pray and how to receive God's life into our own.

These days between Ascension and Pentecost, then, are meant to be a time of intentional prayer for a renewed outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon us. In recent days, our Archdiocese has welcomed over 1000 new Catholics, including several right here at SMM. Our seventh graders have been confirmed, and our second graders have made their first Holy Communion. Pope Leo XIV has been elected as the new Roman Pontiff. All this is the work of grace in our lives and our world. Do we dare ask for more? Of course! God knows what we need even before we ask, but we really do have to ask, because like any good Father, he will not force us to accept something we don't want. That's where the concept of a novena comes from: the nine days (or in some cases, nine weeks) of prayer are not some sort of magic number, but simply a gift of persistent prayer to God for an increase in charity, or for understanding into a teaching of the Church, or for healing of body or soul for someone we love.

In that Upper Room, the entire Church was present. That's all there was: Mary, eleven flawed apostles, some faithful women, and Jesus' relatives. One could be forgiven for thinking that such a group—armed with a strange story about a dead criminal being alive again—would not amount to much. And yet, here we are. Prayer and openness to the work of the Holy Spirit can literally change human history. In these privileged days, may we be united intensely to pray that God will fill us with renewed spirit of holiness and joy in imitation of Mary, the apostles, and all the saints. 🌿
