The Saints Bless Us with Hope to Become Models of Mercy



Jesus came to give us hope; to heal us of our sins and free us from the power of death. By sacrificing his life and rising to eternal life, Jesus reveals to us how we can offer our lives and transform our culture of death into a living and loving communion of saints.

Saints are sinners who strive with trust in Christ's mercy and can grow in holiness and rejoice in sharing their experiences with others. Saints are humble but confident, believe the Scriptures, and receive the Sacraments. They live lives of virtue and serenity.

They rejoice in witnessing that we, too, can overcome despair by praying for the conversion of our loved ones and those who persecute us.

In today's gospel, Jesus heals Peter's mother-in-law and spends all day healing and delivering people from evil spirits. The devil is the source of evil and constantly tempts us to despair. Jesus offers us hope in God's Powerful Spirit, our spiritual GPS, who blesses us with wisdom, confidence, and courage to

avoid sin and grow as Missionary Disciples of Jesus.

Take time to learn about your patron saint and see how you can imitate their life of virtue.

"To err is human. To forgive is divine." All love relationships progress through five stages—Romance, Disillusionment, Misery, Makeup, and True Joy. As children, we look to our parents to show us how to respond like Jesus with reverence and respect.

In adolescence, we tend to rebel from family to experience and test how peers and authority live and love. As adults, we face the reality and responsibility to practice our Catholic faith through worship, formation, and charity. As elders, we can pass on the gift of peace. "Lord, grant us the serenity to accept the things we cannot change, the courage to change the things we can, and the wisdom to know the difference." Throughout all these stages, as his Missionary Disciples, we must work to convert others by practicing acts of kindness through divine mercy and charity.

Most penitents come to Reconciliation with low spirits but leave with joyful spirits. I challenge all of us, especially parents, to receive and witness the miracles in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Sacrament is not just confessing your sins; it has four essential components. First, God is always loving and forgiving. Second, By confessing our sins, we profess our trust that Jesus paid the price for us on the Cross. Third, God has given his divine authority to the priest to pardon and absolve all sins. Finally, we resolve not to sin again and forgive those who sin against us.

NEW! THANKSGIVING PRAYER SERVICE HONORING OF FR. BILL ATKINSON THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 22

Join us at 6:30 PM on **Thursday, February 22**, for a **Prayer Service of Thanksgiving** in the church to remember the anniversary of Father Bill Atkinson's accident and to thank the Servant of God for his intercessions. Afterward, join us in St. Francis Hall for refreshments, a prayer testimonial of parishioner and traumatic accident survivor **Cole Keith**, and a brief presentation about a legacy "Sit, Rest, Pray, Heal" **Sculpture Memorial Project** in recognition of Fr. Bill Atkinson, OSA.

As we honor Fr. Bill Atkinson's legacy and celebrate his journey toward sainthood, his friends and family are diligently working to construct three sculptures to memorialize his example of virtue and dignity. The legacy project "*Sit, Rest, Pray, Heal*" consists of a life-sized permanent bronze sculpture of the Augustinian priest, complete with a bench where visitors can reflect and pray, created by artist Timothy Schmalz. The first is in the Healing Garden of St. Augustine Parish in Old City Philadelphia, the first formation of Augustinians in America, and the founding location of Villanova University. The second sculpture is at Bonner-Pennington Catholic High School, where Fr. Bill served for nearly thirty years. Additionally, they plan to place a third sculpture in Rome, Italy, at the International Headquarters of the Augustinians.

About Fr. Bill Atkinson, OSA

On February 22, 1965, at age 19, Bill experienced a traumatic spinal injury in a tobogganing accident during his novitiate as a seminarian and could not move his body; however, he continued his studies to become a priest without any guarantee of being able to be ordained. Fr. Bill needed the pope to override Canon Law to be ordained, demonstrating his life, development, health, and abilities were suitable for holy orders.

A telegram with three words: "Atkinson



"Dispensation Granted," came from the pope on August 8, 1973. Nine years after his accident, on February 2, 1974, he was ordained at his hometown parish of St. Alice's in Upper Darby. The Most Reverend Charles Chaput, the former Archbishop, officiated at the formal rite, which began this beloved Augustinian priest's beatification and canonization process. The formal rite earned Fr. Bill the title "Servant of God" and was the first step toward making him the Catholic Church's first quadriplegic priest into a saint.




