Dear Parishioners and Friends,

While I enjoy serving as your pastor, I realize that my physical health limits my ability to fulfill all my duties to the extent I have previously. For the good of the parish and my health, I have decided to retire this June. I wrote the following letter to Archbishop Nelson Pérez, thanking him for allowing me to serve as your pastor for an additional year despite the agreement that priests are expected to retire at seventy-five years of age:

"Praise God, and thank you for the joy of serving you and our Archdiocese of Philadelphia since my ordination in 1975. For the glory of God, the good of the parishioners, and my health, I respectfully request your blessing in retiring this June as pastor of Saint Mary Magdalen Parish.

I believe God's Powerful Spirit has graced and guided me to make this decision. My Parkinson's Disease is progressing, and I am not able to perform all of the pastoral duties needed to serve such a large, vibrant faith community adequately.

Saint Mary Magdalen parishioners are blessed with many gifted leaders to promote our Parish Mission Statement, "Building a family of faith in Jesus Christ through Catholic Worship, Formation, and Charity." I pray that your choice of a new pastor will continue collaborating with our deacons and leaders who facilitate our fifty-eight ministries for the good of our parish family and our Archdiocese."

I pray for your prayers and understanding as I continue to serve you as your pastor until June and as I begin a new phase of my life. Always remember, YOU DO YOUR BEST AND GOD WILL DO THE REST!

Join us at 6:30 PM on **Thursday, February 22**, for a **Prayer Service of Thanksgiving** in the church to remember the anniversary of Father Bill Atkinson's accident and to thank the Servant of God for his intercessions. Afterward, join us in St. Francis Hall for refreshments, a prayer testimonial of parishioner and traumatic accident survivor **Cole Keith**, and a brief presentation about a legacy "Sit, Rest, Pray, Heal" **Sculpture Memorial Project** in recognition of Fr. Bill Atkinson, OSA.

As we honor Fr. Bill Atkinson's legacy and celebrate his journey toward sainthood, his friends and family are diligently working to construct three sculptures to memorialize his example of virtue and dignity.

The legacy project "**Sit, Rest, Pray, Heal**" consists of a life-sized permanent bronze sculpture of the Augustinian priest, complete with a bench where visitors can reflect and pray, created by artist Timothy Schmalz. The first is in the Healing Garden of St. Augustine Parish in Old City Philadelphia, the first formation of Augustinians in America, and the founding location of Villanova University.

The second sculpture is at Bonner-Penergast Catholic High School, where Fr. Bill served for nearly thirty years. Additionally, they plan to place a third sculpture in Rome, Italy, at the International Headquarters of the Augustinians.
