Dear Faithful & Friends,

Praised be Jesus Christ! The recent Gospel readings for Sunday have focused on the establishment of the hierarchical Church with Peter as the Vicar of Christ. Last Sunday, Our Lord revealed His Passion to the Apostles for the first time and points us to His role as Eternal Judge.

This week He teaches the Apostles and us about living in community as a Church.

An essential reality of being a member of the Church, the Body of Christ, is how we treat one another in a parish.

Our good Lord knows that there will be moments of disagreement, frustration, and sin. He does not want us to be naive to the temptations that surround us as we strive for holiness in a fallen world. Therefore, He explains to us how to handle these situations living in a community of believers, "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother" (*Mt 18:15*).

At times, we are all called to either receive or offer fraternal correction. Such fraternal correction is not an act of harshness, but of charity when ordered to each other's salvation. We are concerned not merely with our neighbor's comfort, but with their eternal salvation. This understanding flows from the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Everything that we are and everything that we do as a parish flows from the altar, where the Holy Eucharist is offered and where our Lord Jesus Christ gives Himself entirely to us in Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

We do not come to Mass merely as individuals. We come as members of the Mystical Body of Christ. At the altar, rich and poor, young and old, families and single persons, the strong and the weak are gathered together. We hear the same Word of God, kneel before the same Lord, and are nourished by Him in Holy Communion.

We are here for the worship of Almighty God and for the sanctification of our souls. A parish must be a place where Christ is known, loved, worshipped, and received. Do we not notice a glaring contradiction in receiving the Body of Christ while remaining indifferent to the members of Christ around us? Those who kneel together before the Blessed Sacrament are called to learn how to forgive one another, bear with one another, pray for one another, and assist one another on the road to Heaven. How fitting, then, that our Lord concludes His teaching with these words, "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them" (*Mt 18:20*). He is truly in our midst daily when we are gathered at Mass.

Both our First Reading from the prophet Ezekiel and our Epistle from the Apostle Paul remind us that we are each other's watchmen and owe each other charity. When we go all the way back to the story of Cain and Abel in Genesis, the question "Am I my brother's keeper?" is answered for us, and the answer is, "Yes" (*cf. Gen 4:9*).

Notice that our Lord calls us to keep pursuing reconciliation. If our first attempt fails, then we try again with two others. If that fails, then we keep trying and tell the Church. If that fails, we do not just give up; as our Lord says, "If he refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector" (*Mt 18:17*). Remember how our Lord treated tax collectors and sinners? He would dine with them and invite them to follow Him. We should never give up on a neighbor. Rather, we go back to the beginning and try to show them the love of Christ.

This is not something we must do on our own, especially if we have been seriously hurt by another, but in the context of a community.

As we get ready for Labor Day and return from time away this Summer, it is fitting that we are reminded to live in the presence of Christ and within a parish family. It is also fitting that we celebrate the Nativity of our Lady on September 8<sup>th</sup>. Let us have recourse to Mary, Mother of the Church, to help us love her Son and each other as a parish family. May you and your families have a safe, blessed, and Happy Labor Day!

May our Lord bless you and our Lady keep you!

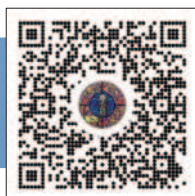

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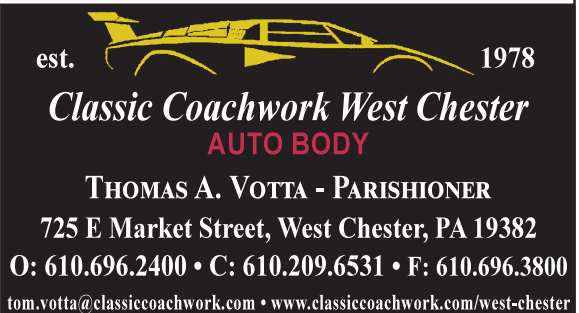
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
