## We are Chosen to be Missionary Disciples



Do you believe that the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus, has the power to free you from the bondage of sin and fear? Like the first fishermen Jesus chose, we, too, are His missionary disciples, called to gather in others for Christ and "to catch people for the kingdom of God." Jesus chose these ordinary people from the working class with little wealth and no position in their community who were capable of doing ordinary things extraordinarily well. He chose these individuals not for what they were but for what they could become under his direction and power. When the Lord calls us to serve, we must not think we have nothing to offer.

God wants to work in and through you for His glory. We will "catch people for the kingdom of God" if we allow the light of Jesus Christ to shine through us. God wants others to see the light of Christ in us in the way we live, speak, and witness the joy of the Gospel.

Paul the Apostles says: "But thanks be to God, who in Christ Jesus always leads us in triumph and, through us, spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere. For we are the aroma of Christ to God among those who are being saved and those who are perishing."

Will you be a witness to those around you about the joy of the Gospel, and will you pray for your neighbors, co-workers, and relatives that they may come to know the Lord Jesus Christ and grow in their knowledge of his love?

**Pray:** "Lord Jesus, you have called me personally by name, just as you called your first disciples, Simon, Andrew, James, and John. Please help me believe your word and follow you faithfully. Please fill me with the joy of the Gospel that your light may shine through me to many others."

In 2015, Pope Francis implemented an initiative for a **Day of Prayer and Reflection against Human Trafficking** on February 8, the Feast of Saint Josephine Bakhita. This initiative raises awareness about the mortal sin and global scourge of human trafficking.

In the Archdiocese, Archbishop Pérez, in conjunction with the Office for Life and Family in partnership with the Sovereign Military Order of Malta, the American Association will launch an Anti-Human Trafficking Awareness Program entitled: "The Samaritans Choice: An Act of Love."

St. Mary Magdalen will present this program on **Monday, February 12**, from 7 to 8:30 PM in St. Francis Hall. It teaches individuals how to identify the signs, report it, and how to support survivors.
