SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

Dear Friends in Christ,

They say that March *comes in like a lion and out like a lamb*. To be honest, I've never heard a clear explanation of that expression. In my mind, there are a few levels to it. On the one hand, there is a change of seasons, and the war which seems to play out each year between winter and spring. March can bring snowstorms and 70-degree days, sun and also strong winds. Then there is the human element to it: March does seem to be a time of new beginnings.

The first day of spring happens in March. The hibernation-like habits we can sometimes adopt in winter start to break up. (New Year's Day used to be in March, not January.) Families tend to make big decisions in March, about jobs, moves, and colleges.

But I do think there is a spiritual side to that saying too. This year, the entire month of March falls within the season of Lent, but will give way immediately to the Sacred Paschal Triduum and Easter.

Out like a lamb, indeed. For Christ is the lamb who was slain for our salvation; his death is the true passover, which saves us all from the death of sin, opening for us the way to eternal life.

On the Second Sunday of Lent, the Church every year recalls the event of the Transfiguration. Though it has a feast day on August 6th, the Gospel of the Second Sunday of Lent always describes this mysterious event on Mount Tabor. What exactly is it about? On the one level, there is Jesus, the divine Son of God, whose divinity has been veiled ever since the Incarnation in the womb of the Virgin shining forth brilliantly, a glimpse of His divinity which is always present, and will always be present, even in the most paradoxical way upon the Cross. But there is also the Apostles: their eyes are opened for a brief moment. They are transformed: ordinary, unimpressive men though they are, they are given a glimpse of the divine majesty which Christ shares with the Father and the Holy Spirit (made present on Tabor through the voice and the cloud).

This is why we read this during Lent: because these same three Apostles—Peter, James, and John—will witness Jesus in His agony in the garden. They will have to make sense of that profound paradox: that the one in whom the Father’s glory shines perfectly is also the man whose prayer is so intense that His sweat falls like drops of blood. The forsaken criminal on the instrument of torture is God in the flesh. We read it so that we might be strengthened in our Lenten resolve—but also so that we might be changed. For what are the sacraments for, if not to transfigure us, to change our mortal bodies into the likeness of Christ’s? Yes, Christ’s divinity was veiled during His earthly ministry, as it is veiled in the Eucharist—and as it is veiled in each of us. But just as the bread and wine are transformed into the very substance of Christ, so true through our participation in the sacraments, we are transformed. We grow in merit before God. We become saints.

In a particular way, I ask all parishioners to offer their prayer, fasting, and almsgiving this Lent for those Elect in our community who will encounter Christ in a definitive way through the reception of Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion at the Easter Vigil—Lisa Colterelli, Jessica Pelish, Sebastian Fitzgerald, and Ian Schlegel. We also pray for those already one with us in Baptism who will be received into the Full Communion of the Catholic Church and/or receive Confirmation and First Communion on the Second Sunday of Easter—Justin Fitzgerald, Lani Fitzgerald, Miranda Fitzgerald, Kristy McCarry, Mark Salamon, Alex Losacco, Daniel Kemp, Serena Hartt, Tyler Deman. May their yes to Christ inspire us all to renew our own.

May the Lord grant you peace!




