Dear Friends in Christ,

So many great initiatives are taking place around our parish during these days of Advent! I want to thank the Knights of Columbus, the McCabe Family, and Michael D'Angelo for their help in making the *Padre Pio relic* event such a success. Everyone who came found it a moving and inspiring way to begin Advent. Thanks as well to Mrs. Sue Mita for sharing with us an eyewitness update on the amazing work of *Saint Mary Magdalene Oasis of Peace School* in Kisumu, Kenya. We will continue accepting donations to be directed to the school over the next two weeks.

I am happy to announce that—in addition to our usual parish Christmas gift of calendars—we are giving an additional Christmas gift this year: a special **parishioner subscription to the Hallow App**. This app features a trove of spiritual and catechetical resources, from an introduction to the Gospels to sacred music to talks by Father Mike Schmitz. There is usually a fee associated with the full app, but parishioners of Saint Mary Magdalen will be able to use a special SMM version of Hallow for free. I am grateful to Mr. Mark Victoria for launching this partnership. He will share details about this with us next weekend.

I intend to have a special celebration in honor of Joe on a Sunday morning in the spring once we coordinate dates with him and his family.

In the meantime, we are in need of nominations for parishioners to serve on the pastoral council. The requirements are the same as those of someone seeking to be a godparent: the nominee must be a fully initiated Catholic who is practicing the faith and, if married, is married validly according to the Church. Of course, the nominee should also be a parishioner of Saint Mary Magdalen. If you wish to submit a nomination, simply email me or write the person's name in an envelope in the Sunday Vespers. The re-constituted council in late January.

In these days of Advent, I ask for your prayers for the fourteen members of our local community, seen in last week's Bulletin, who are journeying with Deacon Bob and Patty Szipszky in the Introduction to Catholicism as catechumens preparing for Baptism at the Easter Vigil, or as your prayers can be of great spiritual assistance as these courageous people—including many young adults—prepare to enter the Catholic Church.
