Dear Faithful & Friends,

Praised be Jesus Christ! Have you noticed how mountains are a frequent location for a mysterious encounter throughout the Bible? For example: Abraham on Mt. Moriah, Moses on Mt. Sinai, Elijah on Mt. Horeb, and Peter, James, and John on Mt. Tabor. Our First Reading is the account of Elijah encountering Almighty God in a “tiny whispering sound” on Mt. Horeb (*1 Kings 19:9a, 11-13a*).

Reflecting on the prophets and their mysterious encounters, the current *Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches:

In their ‘one to one’ encounters with God, the prophets draw light and strength for their mission. Their prayer is not flight from this unfaithful world, but rather attentiveness to the Word of God. At times their prayer is an argument or a complaint, but it is always an intercession that awaits and prepares for the intervention of the Savior God, the Lord of history. (CCC 2583).

Remember Elijah’s encounter on Mt. Horeb in *1 Kings* happens after he challenged the false prophets of Baal and called Israel back to right worship. He was on the run for his life from King Ahab and Jezebel. Elijah encountered the mysterious presence of Almighty God in a moment of great need.

On Thursday, we celebrated the Feast of the Transfiguration. On Mt. Tabor, Christ revealed His divine glory as a preview of His glorious return and our own resurrection. Our Lord led Peter, James, and John up the mountain and was transfigured as a way to prepare them for the scandal of the cross on Mt. Calvary. Christ anticipates their faith being tested and offers them a glimpse of His glory to reassure them.

Our Gospel for Mass also recounts a mysterious encounter between the disciples and our Lord.

Although it does not take place on a mountain, notice our Lord goes up the mountain to pray before walking on the sea. When our Lord was walking on the Sea of Galilee, the disciples were terrified and thought it was a ghost. Peter calls to Jesus, *"Lord, if it is you, command me to come to you on the water."*

After our Lord invites him, Peter walks out on the water but begins to sink when fear overtakes him.

He calls out to Jesus to save him, and our Lord immediately stretches out His hand.

As we reflect on these mysterious encounters, consider how the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is our own privileged meeting with our Lord. Notice how our altar is elevated by steps. The Church intentionally draws our attention upward, reminding us that the one sacrifice of Christ on Mt. Calvary is made sacramentally present upon the altar.

Today, we are blessed like the prophets and disciples to encounter the living God. We have this opportunity through, with, and in Jesus Christ at the Mass. We come in humility, recognizing our need but also attentive to Jesus, the Eternal Word. The prophets in their need and attention were preparing for the intervention of a saving God. Do we have this same attitude at Mass? May the Holy Spirit help us at each Mass to deepen our expectation of encountering the living Christ and transform us so that others recognize His presence in us.

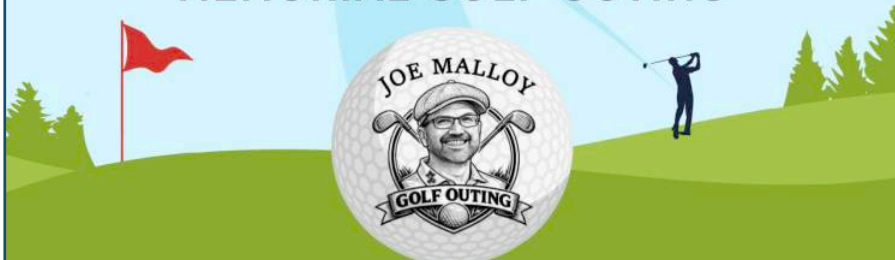

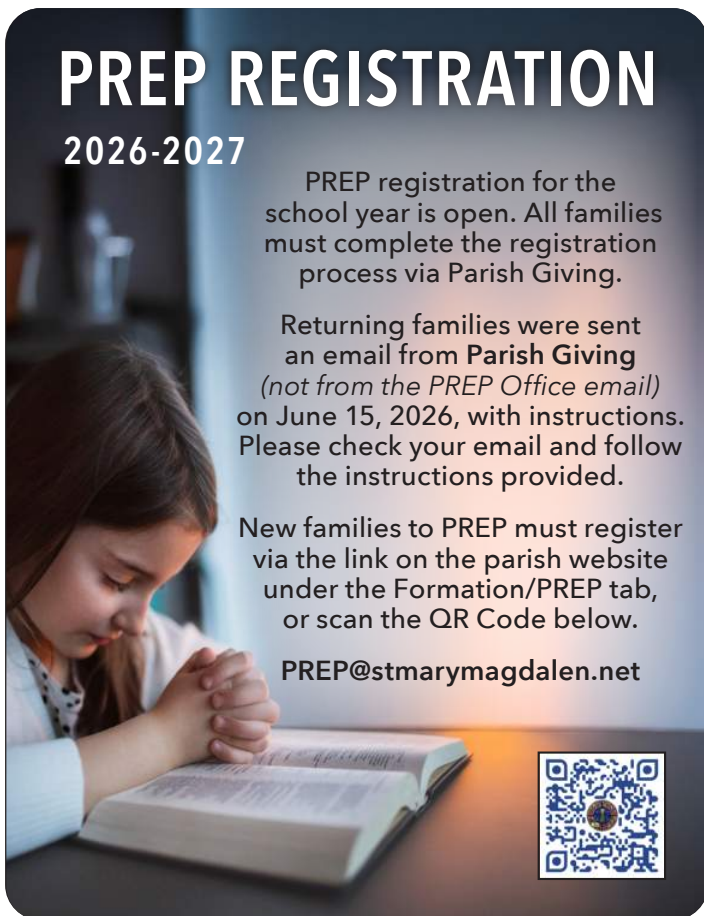

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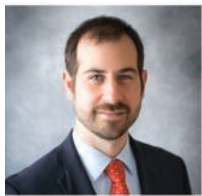


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
