THE SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

No Pain, No Gain, No Cross, No Crown



Missionary Disciples endure suffering and sacrifice with Jesus on Good Friday to enjoy new life on Easter Sunday. As Jesus willingly embraced the Cross to demonstrate his unconditional love and mercy, we must pay the cost of disciplining our selfishness and growing in charity. Because we make thirty thousand decisions daily, God's Powerful Spirit graces and guides us to choose His will. His plan blesses us with divine love, mercy, peace, and joy.

Faith enables us to see what is hidden just as Abraham, Moses, and Elijah saw and dedicated their lives to God. In the Gospel, Jesus appeared in glory with Moses, the great lawgiver, and Elijah, the greatest of the prophets. Jesus knew in Jerusalem of his betrayal, rejection, and crucifixion.

He wanted to prepare Peter, James, and John that his death is the door to the Resurrection. Just as Moses and Elijah endured much suffering to keep our Jewish brethren faithful, Christ's glory would be theirs if they sacrificed their lives to share in it.

God the Father revealed to the disciples that Jesus was His beloved Son, saying, "This is my beloved Son; listen to him." Baptism calls us to share God's glory and witness to others his presence and power to be holy. Are you willing to embrace the Cross of growing in reverence for God and respect for yourself and others by taking responsibility for building a family of faith through Catholic worship, education, and charity?

The empty Cross on the altar invites us to unite our intentions with his crucifixion to bless us with a share in his Resurrection.



RADIATING CHRIST

Dear Jesus, help me to spread Your fragrance wherever I go. Flood my soul with Your spirit and life. Penetrate and possess my whole being so utterly, that my life may only be a radiance of Yours. Shine through me, and be so in me that every soul I come in contact with may feel Your presence in my soul. Let them look up and see no longer me, but only Jesus! Stay with me and then I shall begin to shine as You shine, so to shine as to be a light to others. The light, O Jesus, will be all from You; none of it will be mine. It will be you, shining on others through me. Let me thus praise You the way You love best, by shining on those around me. Let me preach You without preaching, not by words but by my example, by the catching force of the sympathetic influence of what I do, the evident fullness of the love my heart bears to You. Amen.

I, the deacons, staff, and ministry council leaders look forward to and will continue to serve our parish family, and I will provide you with any additional information as it becomes known.

I hope for your prayers and understanding as I continue to serve you as your pastor until June and as I begin a new phase of my life.

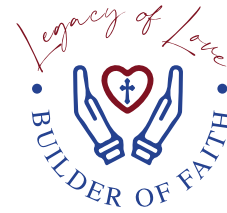
